



CAPITAL PROJECTS UPDATE



Enumclaw High School's Phase 2, Area 5 will expand the spaces used by health and physical education with a wrestling room and three classrooms, plus adds an incredible music education suite. The recent snow storms did not impact the construction schedule -- way to go FORMA Construction and each of the dedicated subcontractors!

Recent projects include:

1. Roof Anchors/Roof Drains/Roof Penetrations is ongoing.
2. Roof Framing/Sheathing in all areas (except Mezz Roof) is ongoing.
3. Roof Dry In/Roofing has begun and is ongoing.
4. Crane Onsite Erecting remaining Walls and Roof on Feb 13th and 14th.
5. Pick Up framing continues.
6. Early Wall Rough-In for Insulation/Pre-Rock is ongoing.
7. LVL Wall Framing/Sheathing 1st Floor Clearstory (Framed in Place on Building Slab) is complete.
8. Re-Steel of Chiller Pad is complete.
9. Plumbing/Piping Rough-In is ongoing.
10. Electrical Rough-In has begun and is ongoing.
11. Chiller has been placed.
12. F/P/S Footings for Chiller Yard (Pour) is complete.
