






Juanita High School

Planned Opening: September 2020 - one year early







Finished Site Plan

Juanita High School






















Elementary School Additions Kirkland Area






Elementary School Additions Sammamish Area








Program Cost Update

Construction

The district's growing enrollment is evidence that LWSD attracts families to the area it serves in Kirkland, Redmond and Sammamish, Washington. To serve that growing enrollment, the district is "Building on Success." That's the district's long-term plan to continue to build schools and to provide quality learning environments and experiences.

Current Construction: 2019 Capital Projects Levy

In April 2019, voters approved a capital projects levy that provides:

- Classroom space for 1,052 students by providing additions at five schools for a total of 44 new classrooms
- Expansion of commons and auxiliary gym space at Lake Washington High School (LWHS) and expansion
 of core facilities at the identified elementary schools where feasible.

Ordered additional equipment

- Snow plows
- Sand/ice melt spreader
- Walk behind snow sweeper

Custodial equipment added

- Ice-cleats
- Established service agreements with two plowing services



Winter Storm Efforts (January 13 – 15)

Staff Coverage

- 8,000 tons of snow removed
- 900 miles of area cleared
- 1,700 labor hours

Materials Used

- 12 tons of ice melt
- 65 tons of sand
- 1600 gallons of de-icer

Equipment (16 hours/day)

- 4 Snowplows
- 2 Sanding/Ice Melt Truck
- 2 Skid Steer / Tractor
- 6 Powered Snow Movers (blowers, brush, bull)
- Contractor Assistance
 - 6 Snowplows
 - 6 Tractors / Front loaders

- High School 8 hours


