



GIRLS' SCHOOL UNIFORM (Years 7 - 11)

The school's aim in its choice of uniform is that the girls at Dame Allan's should look smart and businesslike. To this end we have chosen a uniform that is both practical and hard-wearing and we rely on the co-operation of both parents and pupils in maintaining a high standard of dress. The major uniform items must be purchased from our official suppliers Schoolblazer. Correct school uniform must be worn in school and during journeys to and from school. Pupils should look neat and tidy at all times. Hair must be kept clean and tidy: hair must be of a natural colour. No coats may be worn around the school buildings. No leather, suede or denim outer garments are to be worn.

A OUTDOOR UNIFORM

1. A plain dark coloured or black coat, fleece or school regulation PE splash jacket (excluding any garment made of denim, leather or suede). Games kit or other hoodies may not be worn as a coat.
2. Plain black or maroon scarf (no other colours are acceptable and scarves may not be worn around school).
3. School hat and hat-band (to be worn for school services in the Cathedral).

NB Boots and the Dame Allan's track suit may be worn on the journey to and from school in severe weather, but may **not** be worn in school, unless permission has been given by a member of staff.

B INDOOR UNIFORM: ALL TERMS

1. **Regulation.** Black school fitted jacket with maroon trim and lining and embroidered school crest
2. **Regulation.** Dame Allan's maroon and black checked kilt. NB. Kilts **MUST** be worn on the knee
3. **Regulation.** Y7 – 9 Maroon "V" neck vest with black neck band
4. **Regulation.** Y10 – 11 Black "V" neck vest with maroon neck band
5. White short or long-sleeved blouse with revered collars
6. Head scarf worn for religious reasons should be black or maroon
7. Low-heeled black shoes (no casual shoes)

Heels to be no higher than 2"/5cm (measured at the back)

8. Y7-9 Plain white or black ankle or knee-length socks, or plain black tights
9. Y10 -11 Plain black tights only

NB Jewellery and cosmetics are not allowed. The only exception is a watch and a pair of small, plain ear studs (one stud only may be worn in each lobe). Long hair must be tied back at all times; any hair ribbons, hair bands or clips should be dark and unobtrusive. Hair must be of a natural colour.

(Second-hand uniform sales will be held during the year. Information about these will be circulated.)

Watches and earrings must NOT be worn for PE/Games. Using tape to cover recently pierced ears is not considered an adequate solution. Your support in ensuring any piercing takes place during school holidays (which allows sufficient time for them to heal) is greatly appreciated.

Trainers

One pair of supportive trainers with non-marking soles. Leisure trainers are not suitable for PE and Games, these are trainers which have a totally flat sole and therefore do not give the support necessary for sporting activities (a potential health and safety issue).
