CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT & COORDINATION

Policy

The Supervisory Union Board shall be responsible for establishing a supervisory union-wide curriculum by either developing the curriculum or assisting member school districts to develop it jointly . The Supervisory Union curriculum shall be coordinated to allow students to meet or exceed standards established by the Vermont Board of Education. Curriculum plans shall be coordinated between sending and receiving schools within the Supervisory Union and will be periodically reviewed to determine compatibility with schools outside the Supervisory Union that are attended by students residing within the Supervisory Union.

The Supervisory Union shall assist each school in the Supervisory Union to follow the curriculum developed in accord with this policy.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for assisting the Supervisory Union and member school district boards in the development, implementation, coordination, and evaluation of the curriculum.

The Superintendent shall conduct systematic evaluations of all programs within the curriculum and reported to the Supervisory Union School Board at least annually.
