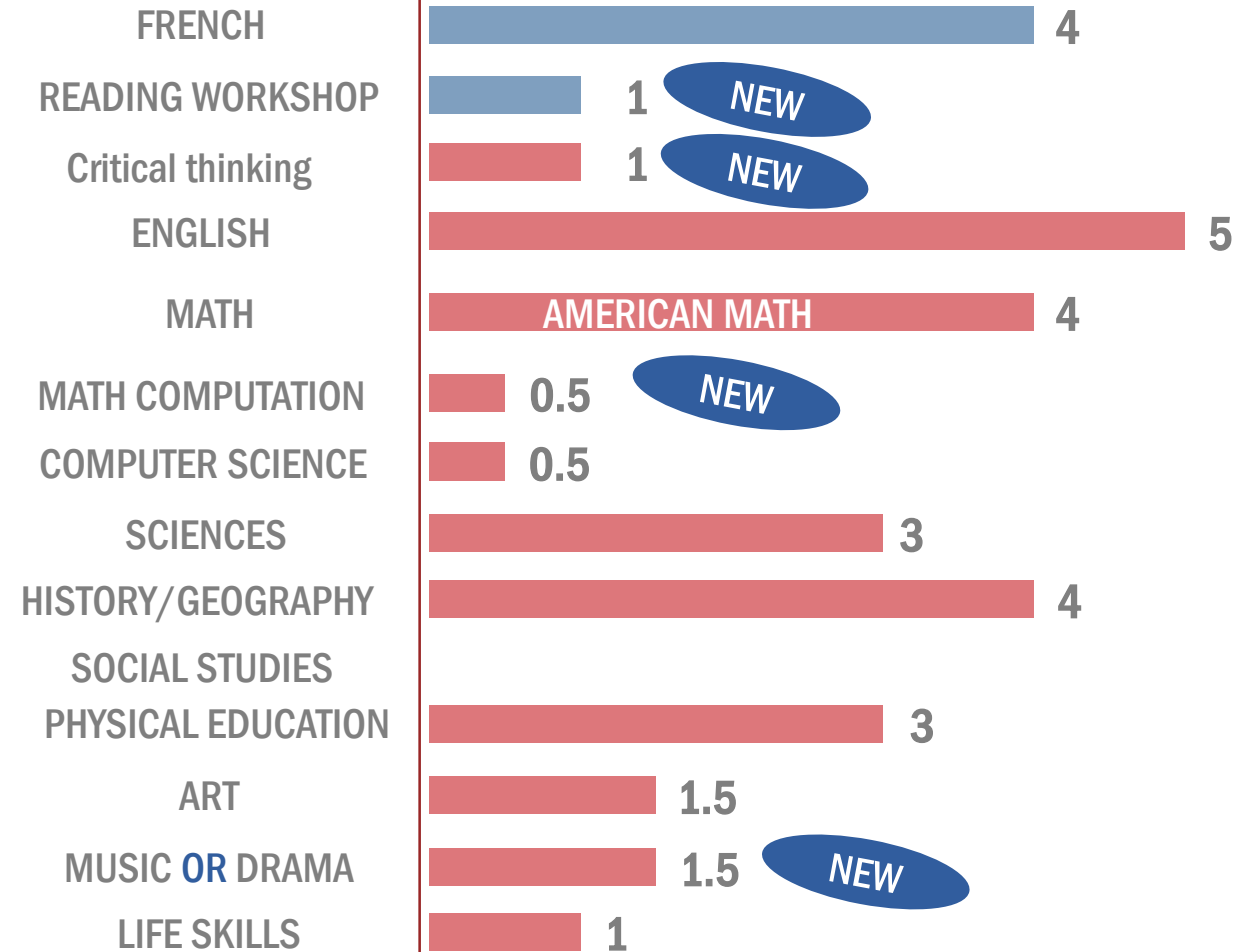


MIDDLE SCHOOL – Subjects split – GRADE 6

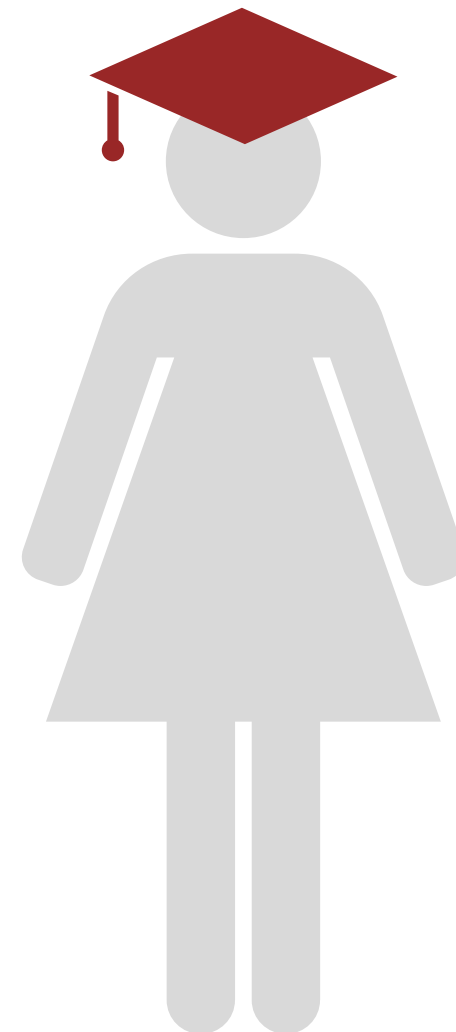
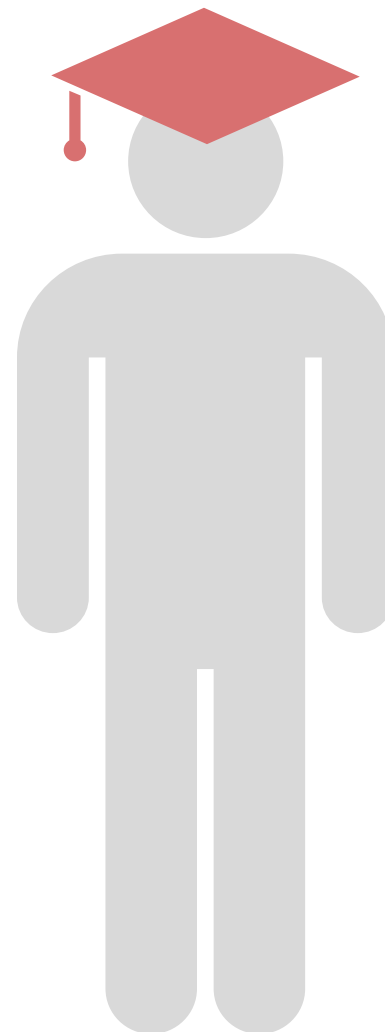
The international track naturally leads to the IB Diploma Program.

Present to students and parents on full range of college application topics

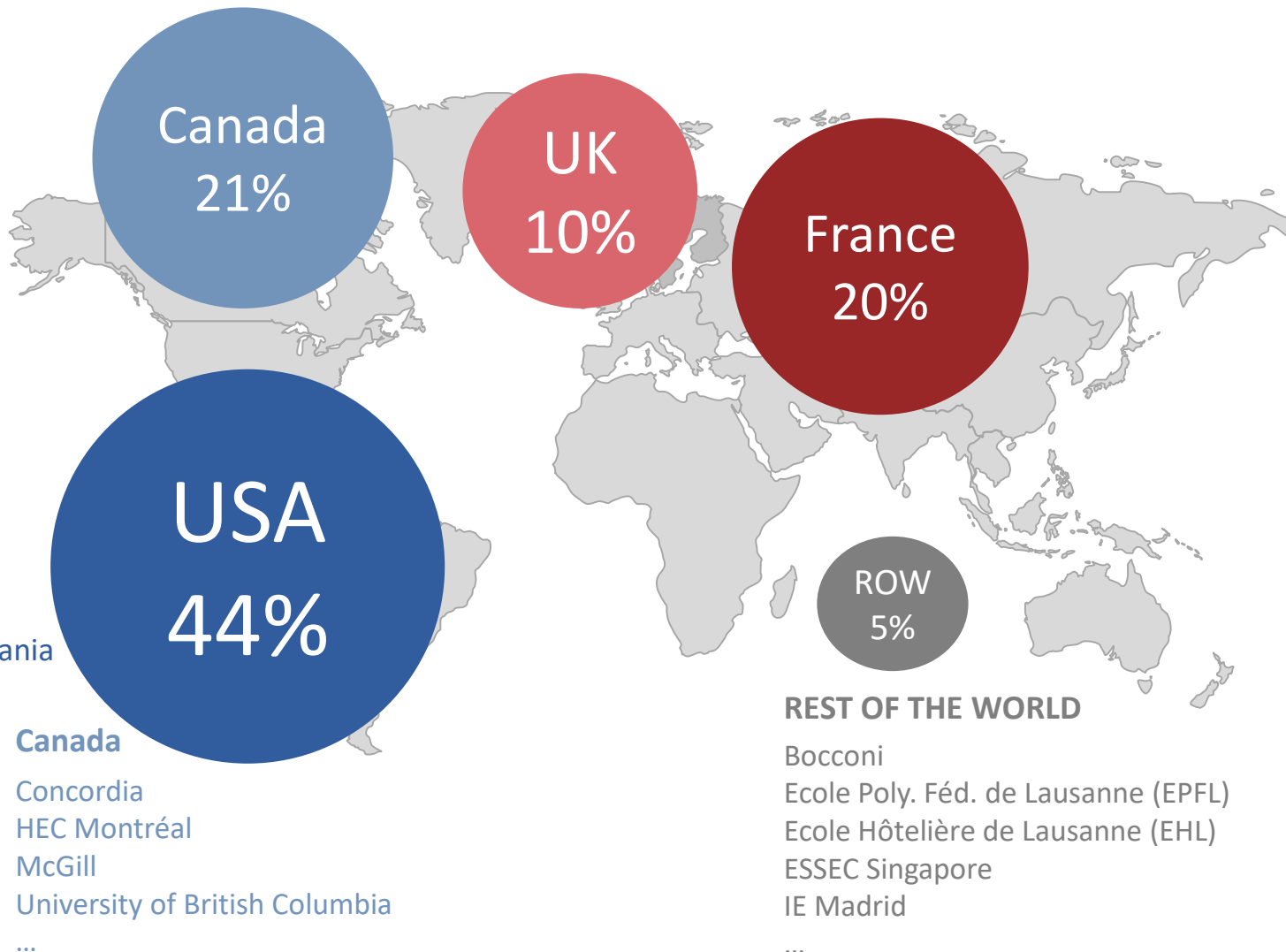

What is the language of instruction in the International Track ?

◆ ENGLISH IS THE MAIN LANGUAGE

No knowledge of French is required.

◆ FRENCH IS LEARNED AT THE STUDENT'S PACE

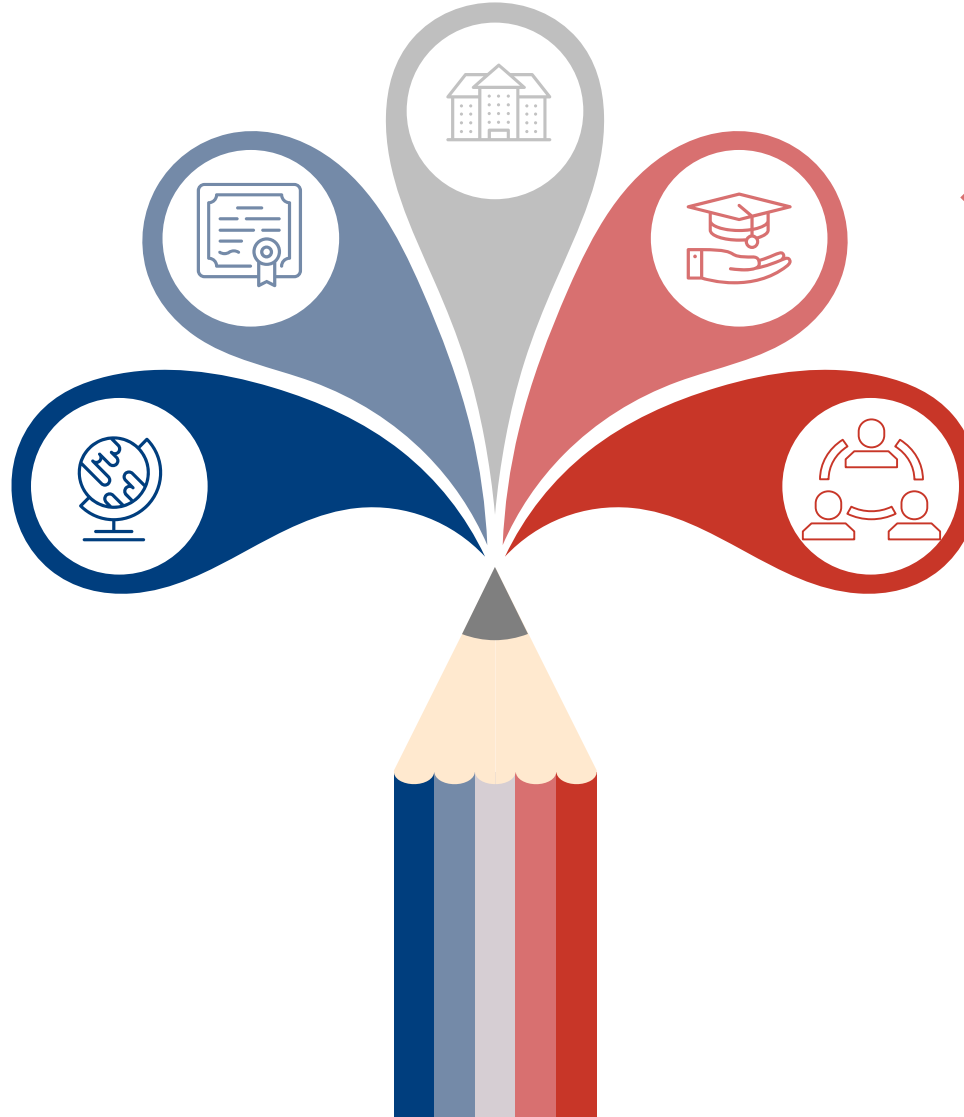
Who should consider the new International Track?

◆ BELONG TO A COMMUNITY

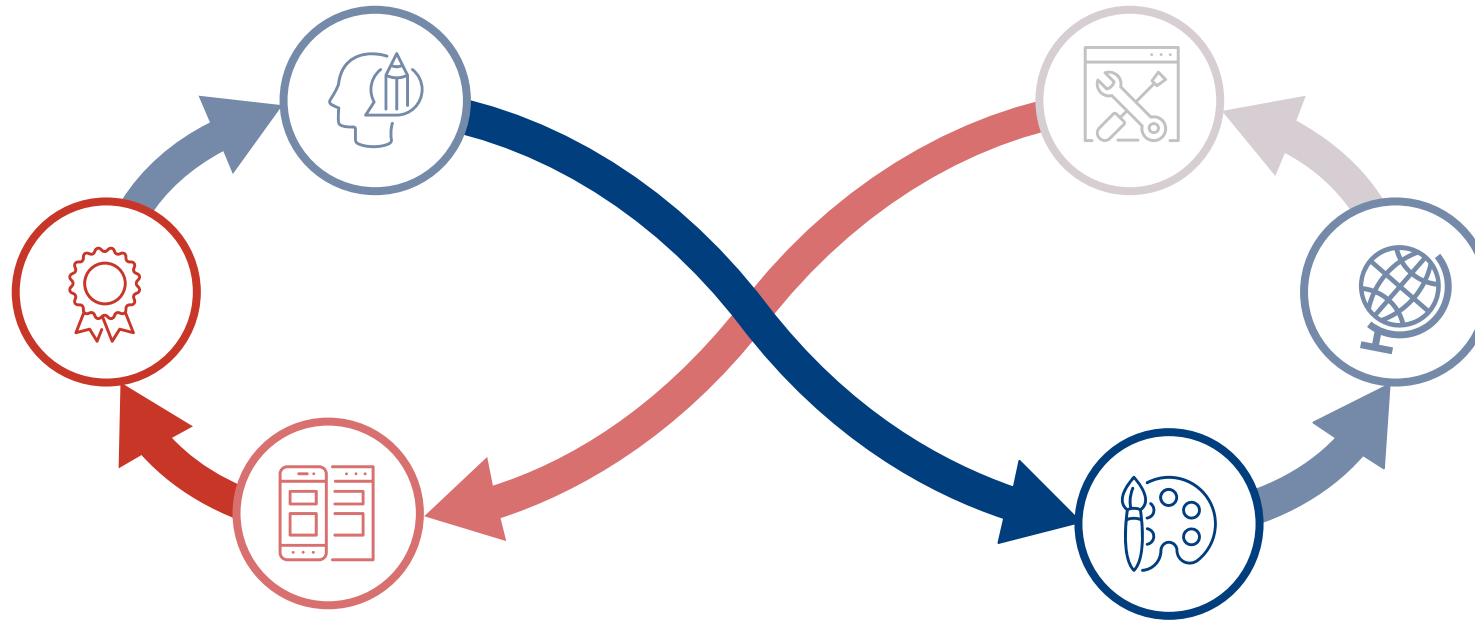
Families who want to belong to the international community.

The program differentiates for student ability so that all students learn the skills needed for proficiency.

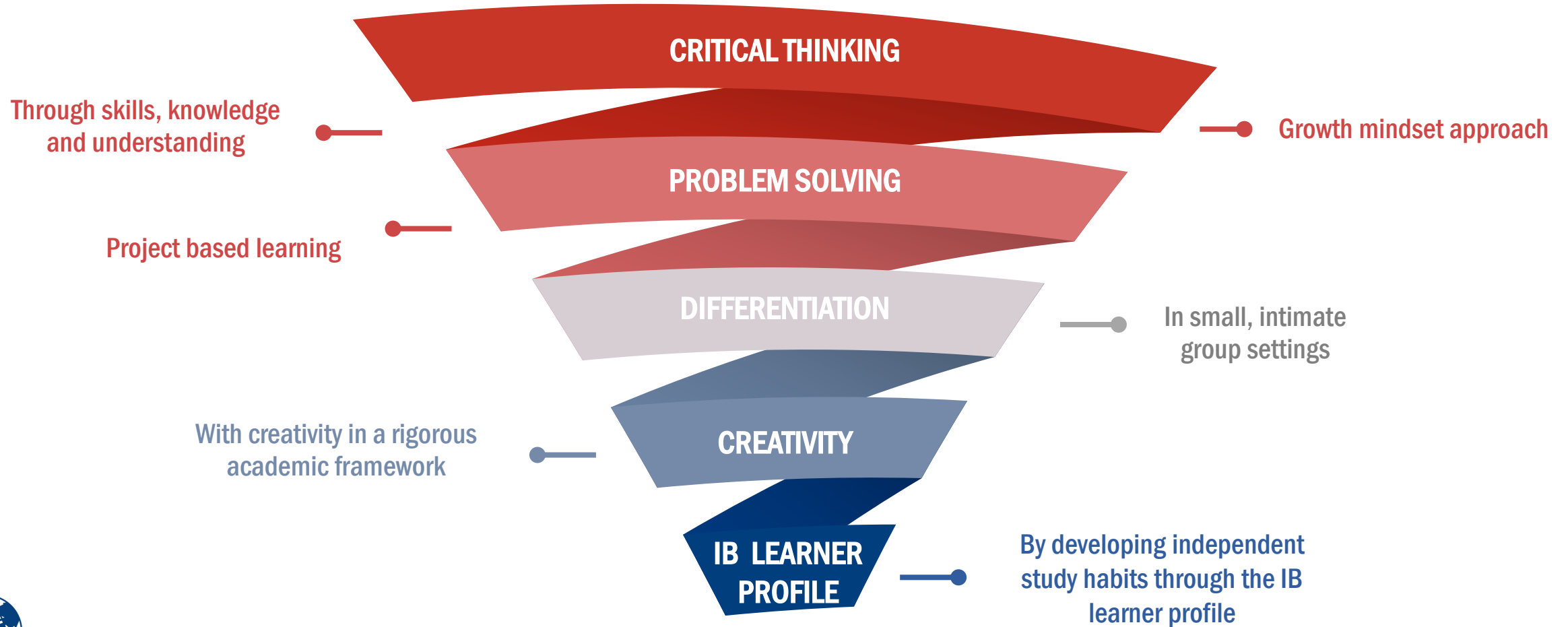


POSSIBILITY TO SWITCH

A switch may be possible, in consultation with the school and depending on the student's language proficiency.



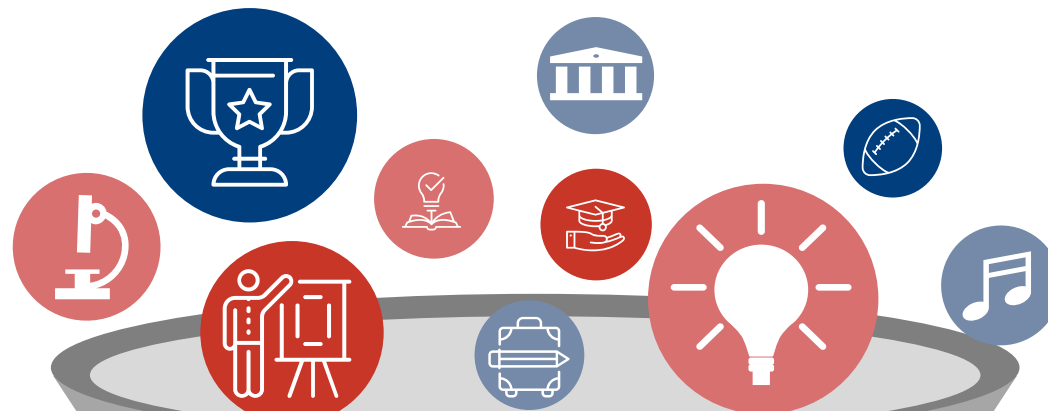
