Weekly classes will be held at Westridge Middle School, 9300 Nieman Rd., June 8 through July 24. Classes will not meet during the week of June 29th. All activities are Monday through Friday. Morning classes are from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon. Afternoon classes are from 1:00 - 4:00 p.m. Tuition for each class is \$95 per week for all students. Two classes per week are \$190.

Smiley Face is for all current pre-k students who will be 4 or 5 years of age by June 1, 2020. Children **must** be toilet trained and may enroll in one or more of these activities in any order. We recommend enrollment in either an AM or PM session but not both. There is a no snack policy in place unless medically required.

Registration is not complete and students will not be allowed to attend class until health history and proof of immunizations are received or updated. Activity A: The Five Senses

My five senses are a part of me, a nose to smell and eyes to see;

This session offers games, activities, and arts and crafts to help you learn about your five senses. You will experiment with sound by making instruments, play a guessing game by using touch, investigate different flavors by taste, and much more.

Activity D: Animals Big & Small

Did you know that animals come in all shapes and sizes? Would you like to go on a virtual animal tour and discover weird animals around the world? Come learn about animals in the jungle, in the desert, and more! We'll learn amazing superpowers and mysteries that animals have, as well as all about wild animals. Learn training tips for pets and how to properly interact with dogs and cats. We'll even have hands-on, interactive experiences with animals, make arts & crafts, and much more!

Activity B: Camping

A camping we will go! Meet new friends and join us on a trip to explore the great outdoors. We're going to make s'mores and catch some fish! Help us discover creatures big and small, but be aware we might see a bear! So if you are up for a camping adventure, this is the place to be. Great for those who have camped before or those who have never been camping! Designed to help you discover that camping is fun!

Activity E: Space

Ready to be a fearless explorer? Have you ever looked at the night sky and wondered, "What else is out there?" Do you like to build rockets and space shuttles? Come blast off with us to space and learn about space travel, astronauts, stars, and our Solar System with crafts, stories, songs, and games. Explore space in a fun and interactive way. Come, learn, and explore the universe!

Activity C: Magic

It is going to be a magical week with lots of tricks up your sleeve! When you graduate from *Magic* school, you will be able to take home your own magic wand, learn how to use your magic finger, create magic milk, and so much more! You will learn magic through hands-on instruction and demonstrations. Be creative and explore! Along with "tricks of the trade", some highlights will be card and rope tricks, mind reading games, improv skills, and stage performance tips.

Activity F: Under the Sea
