

WIC Bilingual Diploma

- **In addition to the Standard Diploma, WIC also offers a Bilingual Diploma (BD).**
- **The key requirement is that students study in two languages (French & English).**
- The bilingual Diploma is awarded to those Grade 12 students who have successfully completed **35 credits of study** in which the language of instruction was French, one DELF Diploma (B1 or B2) and the AP French Language & Culture.
