Middle School Transition Task Force




The Board of Education tasked district administrators with creating a workgroup of district stakeholders to study the feasibility of transitioning the student bodies of Abbott Middle School and Orchard Lake Middle School onto the same campus prior to the opening of West Bloomfield Middle School in 2022.



The need for a **transition plan** was driven by construction timelines for the new West Bloomfield Middle School. Vacating Orchard Lake Middle School during 2021-2022 is necessary to ensure that the new West Bloomfield Middle School is completed on time.





OLMS estimated demolition timeline





The task force was charged with evaluating transition options and making a recommendation to the Board of Education.




Evaluation criteria

Recommended transition plan

- 2020-2021: All students in Grade 6 attend Abbott, and students in Grades 7 and 8 attend Abbott or OLMS as regularly scheduled
- 2021-2022: All middle school students in Grades 6-8 attend Abbott.


Staffing

 Some staff from OLMS will move to Abbott in order to maintain staffing levels, class sizes and elective offerings consistent with current middle school practices




Timeline






Task force recommendation presented to Board of Education at study session
