



## **TEACHING IN L4L**

### **Working arrangements for staff teaching in Literacy for Life.**

Teachers in Year 7 Literacy for Life teach for 17 hours per week compared to a standard teaching week of 22 hours out of 25. In return staff are expected to:

- Have a pastoral and academic interest in their students.
- Supervise break on a rota basis.
- Eat lunch with their class (lunch is provided for staff).
- Supervise the playground at lunchtime on a rota basis.
- Provide intervention to students to help them to progress.
- Provide at least one extra curricular activity.

Staff can expect:

- To teach one class of 25 students.
- Team planning time built into the timetable.
- A fully structured, resourced and planned curriculum.
- A team ethos.

Teachers in Year 8 teach Literacy for Life for 13 hours per week and teach 5-6 hours per week in their specialist subject. While these hours are correct as of this advert, the Trust reserves the right to alter them in the future as the curriculum develops or to ensure the smooth running of the Academy.
