Carroll School trains teachers. In an effort to address the greatest need of each child, we recognize that diversity and inclusivity are essential to a child’s learning experience, as are great teachers. That's why we've established The Angela Wilkins Fellowship for Teachers of Color.

About the Fellowship

The fellowship provides two full scholarships for teachers of color for a collaborative masters degree and licensure program in Moderate Disabilities PreK-8 & 5-12 with Lesley University, a 14-month intensive residency-based graduate program.

Two chosen candidates receive a \$20,000 scholarship for courses taken at Lesley and forgives the cost of courses taken at Carroll School, including free Orton-Gillingham training and certification.

Recruitment: August 2019 - April 13, 2020

Candidate Requirements:

1. Completed undergraduate degree.
