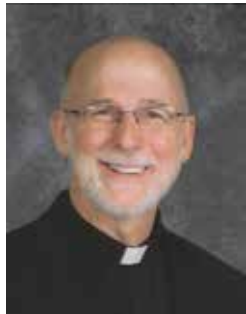

FASTING

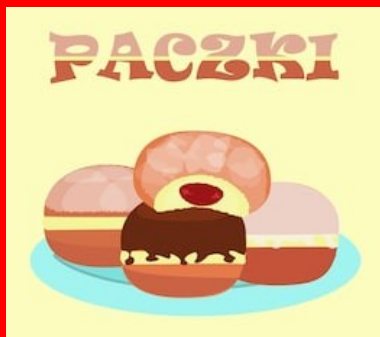
- ♦ Every person **14 years of age or older** must abstain from meat (and items made with meat) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and every Friday during Lent.
- ♦ Every person between the **age of 18 and 59** (beginning of 60th year) must **fast** on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. When **fasting**, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal, according to Canon law & the U.S. Bishops.
- ♦ Fast from gossip, criticism or insensitive, cruel comments towards others.
- ♦ Unplug electronics for 20 minutes every day and spend time in silent prayer.
- ♦ Give up a habit that keeps you from being whom God is calling you to be.
- ♦ Join us for our Lenten Fish Dinners on Fridays from 4pm-7pm in the High School Cafeteria.

ALMSGIVING

- ♦ Donate to Divine Child's annual Catholic Services Appeal (CSA) collection.
- ♦ Volunteer your time at a local soup kitchen or other charitable organization.
- ♦ Give to the St. Vincent de Paul Poor Box located on the back wall of the church.

Venerable Pierre Toussaint — philanthropist and former slave.

Pierre Toussaint was born a slave in Haiti and died a free man in New York City. He dedicated his life to EVANGELICAL CHARITY, using whatever means he had to treat others with dignity.

When political and racial conflict arose in Haiti, Pierre's master brought him to New York, where he apprenticed as a hairdresser. He gained popularity among the upper class, and when he was freed, he used his saved money and status to buy his sister's freedom.

Pierre got married, adopted his niece after her mother's death, and dedicated himself to a life of charity. He raised funds for the city's first school for black children; brought orphans into his home for education; helped Haitian immigrants; and donated to many Catholic organizations.

He attended daily Mass at St. Peter's in NYC for 66 years and was buried outside St. Patrick's Old Cathedral.

Venerable Pierre Toussaint, pray for us — that we would remember to see the dignity in our brothers and sisters, and that we would love them as they deserve.

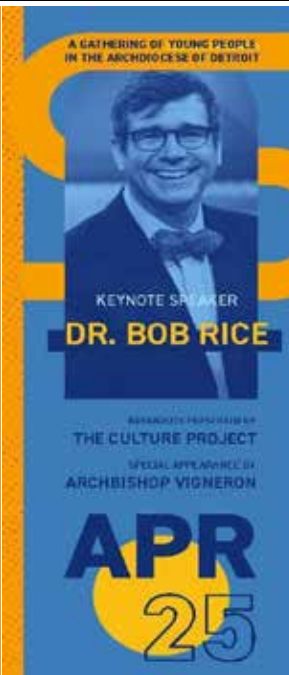

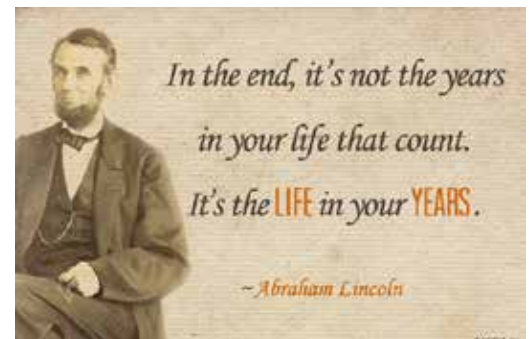

NATIONAL MARRIAGE WEEK ...and THE SACRIFICE OF LENT

Last Sunday was World Marriage Sunday and National Marriage Week continued through this past week. If you are married, you certainly have cause to celebrate. Anyone who is married understands the concept of compromise. Any man or woman in a long marriage will tell you that there is no such thing as 50/50 in a marriage. You always must give more than you take; and YOU are always the one who is giving more (at least from your point of view). Marriage is not an easy vocation, but anything worthwhile is never easy. I always say the only thing more difficult than marriage is raising kids! Both worthy endeavors take a lot of work, love, time and most of all commitment.

In one of his homilies at daily Mass, Fr. Matt quoted Dostoevsky "Love in action is a harsh and dreadful thing compared to love in dreams." He followed up with saying that "the love of our dreams is not the love of reality, and that true love is sacrifice and commitment!" In the early newlywed stage, marriage is consumed with physical love and playfulness. As the newness fades and we begin to blend our lifestyles we see the humanness of our spouse. Some of those things that we found charming are now annoying. Anyone married for some time can relate to this and understand as the years go by what "love" is. To stay on our game and make a solid marriage we must work at it, and it is a constant effort.

The state of marriage has a great effect on a family's foundation and society and a nation. A healthy marriage should bring life into each spouse as we are supposed to build each other up. Not only will a strong marriage prove witness to our children, but society needs to recognize strong families and healthy marriages. Television programs continually show broken families with no father. If fathers are in the show, they are made to be weak and incompetent. Strong marriages and families will counteract this unfortold effect of Hollywood.

We are not naïve to believe that marriage is everyone's solution to happiness. Sometimes marriage feels like a roller-coaster. We find ourselves unable to forgive each other's shortcomings and we know there are times we do not live up to our spouse's or even our own expectations. It is these times, more than ever that we need to invite God back into our marriage; remembering the covenant we made between each other and God on our wedding day. We harken back to the advice our mother or grandmother may have shared with us on our wedding day. "There are not two people in your marriage, there are three. Never forget to keep God in your marriage." It is that work, that prayer, that sacrifice that will help us grow stronger and happier in our marriage.

There is no better time to sacrifice than Lent! As we close out National Marriage Week and Lent begins in a little more than a week, why not offer something up this Lent that will strengthen your marriage. 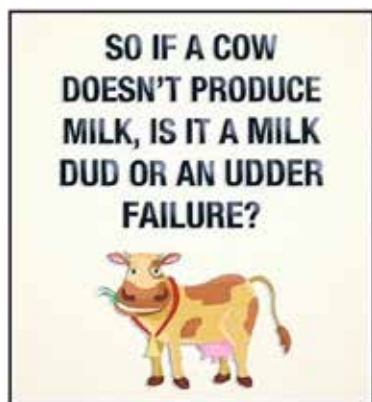
