- Self-confidence
- Resilience
- Emotional regulation
- Positive and successful learning
- Strategies to pursue life-long learning
- Maturity to become successful independent citizens in and beyond school.

Drop-In support

Students who need a chat with a member of the Inclusion staff because they are not coping with an aspect of school or home are free to drop-in to Inclusion for pastoral support at the following times;

Mon-Fri 8.30-8.50am

Mon-Fri 10.50-11.10am (Break time)

Mon-Fri KS4 12.50-1.30pm, KS3 1.40-2.20pm (Lunch time)

We also hold a 'Young Carers' Drop-In on Tuesdays 1.00-1.30pm in G1005

Inclusion Staff

We have a team of three Learning Mentors and two specialist teaching assistants. They all have extensive experience of pastorally supporting young people and liaising with parents and teachers. They have a solid understanding of a range of needs and they can work with students individually, in small groups and in-class.

Group work

Students are referred for group work generally by their Year Learning Co-ordinators or internally by Inclusion staff. The interventions include:

- Behaviour Modification
- Emotional Literacy
- Resilience
- Anxiety Management

Each intervention has a baseline and end-point assessment in order to ensure that the programmes are correctly targeted and effective.
