





Overview of the K-2 model

- Core subjects split
 50% in Spanish, 50%
 in English
- Two teachers; one speaks in Spanish, one speaks in English
- 50/50 research-based "Utah" model instead of one-way immersion
- Four sections per grade level required







- ★ In order of the online applications according to time and date
