PARENT/STUDENT SUMMER STUDIES AGREEMENT

Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to the Gulliver Preparatory Summer Studies program! I am delighted with your interest in our program and look forward to your participation. Summer Studies is committed to personal success and academic achievement. It offers students the opportunity to enroll in three- and six-week courses designed to maximize their potential. In order to maintain a superior college preparatory environment, the following guidelines must be observed:

1. **Attendance** – Classes have been scheduled with an exact number of hours allocated to award academic credit under Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) standards. As a result, in a credit class, a student may not miss the equivalent of more than ONE day in a three-week session, or TWO days in a six-week session. If a student exceeds these absences, NO CREDIT will be received for the course—hours lost due to tardiness or early dismissal will be counted towards an absence. There are no exceptions to this rule. All classes will meet at the Prep Campus.
2. **Respect** – In alignment with Gulliver’s commitment to the community and its core values, students are expected to exhibit mature and responsible behavior towards staff, peers, and school property.
3. **Honor Code** – The Gulliver Preparatory Academic Honor Code (GPAHC) applies at all times. If you are unfamiliar with GPAHC please refer to the student handbook found on the Gulliver Parent Portal.
4. **Dress** – Students are permitted to wear shorts of appropriate length and t-shirts without offensive slogans. Sandals are allowed, but flip-flops are not permitted due to safety concerns.
5. **Student Union/Library/Dining Hall** – These facilities are closed to Summer Studies students. Please plan accordingly.
6. **Grades** – Grades and progress updates will be available to all parents and students on Veracross.
