

# Senior Salute

## Parents of a PC West Senior:

Looking for a creative way to tell your student that you love them and are proud of their accomplishment?

Place a recognition ad (senior salute) in the yearbook!

Senior salutes are a lasting memory that your son or daughter can cherish for a lifetime. They are simple and quick to create.

The salute will be a secret until your child gets their copy of the yearbook. (Ads can also be kept secret from students on the yearbook staff if you specify.)

All salutes are full color and **the yearbook staff will create your ad.**

a) **Pick which size you want the salute to be.** Costs for a staff created ad are-

1/8 page = \$35 (business card size)	1 photo / 50 words
1/4 page = \$60	up to 3 photo / 50 words
1/2 page = \$100	up to 5 photos / 100 words
Full page = \$190	up to 12 photos / 250 words

## b) Choose the photos for the salute.

Please scan photos at 300 DPI and save as a .JPEG (email pics to [jhill@putnamcityschools.org](mailto:jhill@putnamcityschools.org)). This can be done at a local pharmacy store such as CVS. **Be warned that if you just take a picture of a photo, you run the risk of inferior quality!** Remember: The more photos up submit the smaller they will have to be.

## c) Compose the message.

Type all messages out and send them with your photos to [jhill@putnamcityschools.org](mailto:jhill@putnamcityschools.org)  
All font and style decisions will be made by the yearbook staff.

d) You can pay online at <https://bit.ly/2HazRue> until March 12th or payment can be sent to Putnam City West by **March 23** (this is the Monday after Spring Break). Make checks out to PCW Yearbook. **NO ADS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS TIME**
