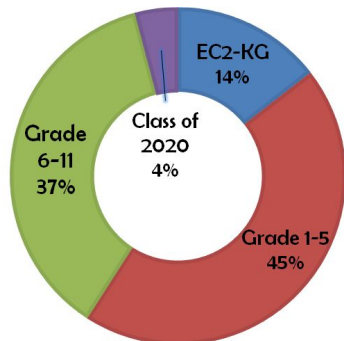

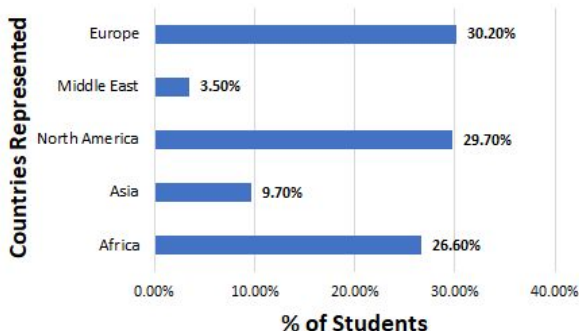

## Advanced Placement & AP Capstone Diploma

ISKR began offering the **AP Capstone Diploma** in 2016-2017, with the first cohort of diploma recipients in 2019. The AP Capstone Diploma is awarded to students who successfully complete two externally-examined rigorous research courses and at least four other discipline-specific AP courses.
