SAN DIEGO VISUAL ART TRIP Potential Itinerary

Hotel: Hampton Inn & Suites Downtown San Diego, 1531 Pacific Hwy, San Diego CA

Oct. 14th, Wednesday

Travel day, leaving mid-day from school on school bus to airport; travel to Hotel, group dinner (students pay for meal), and orientation meeting

Oct. 15th, Thursday

7:00a – 8:00a Complimentary Breakfast in Hotel

8:00a – 9:45a Hotel Conference Room: On-Location Artist Assignments

10:00a Board Shuttle Bus to Zoo

10:30a – 1:00p San Diego Zoo: Photographing & Sketching animals and textures

print to trip journal, and Evening Journaling for all students (purposeful time set aside for journaling, mind-mapping project ideas, inspiration, and addressing the "why's and how's")

Travel day, Parents pick up students from SeaTac Airport (arrival TBA)

Oct. 19th, Mon. – No school. Day to recuperate and complete schoolwork if needed.



What are the Goals for this trip?

An amazing artist opportunity. In designing this trip, our goal was to intentionally open an avenue in which our art students could experience an on-location, learning opportunity to grow in their artistry and learn hands-on as if a career expert. Students will not only practice and grow in skill, but more importantly understand the process of creativity in a real-world experience and address the question, "How do we, as artists, gain inspiration and activate our innovative and imaginative thinking?"

Who is eligible to go on the trip?

Any Visual Arts student who has taken two semesters of a Visual Arts Course (Studio Art 1, 2, 3, Photography 1-2, Sculpture & Mixed Media, and/or Graphic Design 1-2) and is a junior or senior in the 2020-2021 school year. (note, if there are not enough spaces filled by juniors and seniors, sophomores will be allowed to attend on a first come, first serve basis)

How much school will my student miss?

Tentatively, students will only miss 2 days of school: October 16th falls on a day our students do not have school, so they will miss school on the 14th and 15th. Please note that we also do not have school on Monday, October 19th, in which the students may utilize that day to recuperate from our trip as well as complete any needed missed schoolwork. Our goal is for the students to fully immerse themselves during this trip and we have considered this in the planning with the school days they have off to make this experience as rich and full without the stress of missed schoolwork.

How much does the trip cost?

The estimated cost for trip is \$1500. This includes: roundtrip airfare, transportation to venues, hotel for 4 nights, continental breakfasts, admission and fees to venues and events, guest professional honorariums, and trip t-shirt. Expenses not included: meals (lunches and dinners) and any additional souvenirs.
