Kindergarten – 10th Grade Students

If your child enjoys creating and learning about art, this program will be perfect for them. Taught by professional artists and teachers, your young artist will produce amazing artwork. The campers will be using a variety of mediums including painting, pottery, collage, weaving, mosaics, and metal work to name a few.

Your child will learn about different artists and the language and basic techniques of art while creating their own masterpieces. Your young artist will have a chance to swim everyday, and have a daily hour of free period activities to choose from and special camp events each week. The Young Artist Camp runs for nine weeks, with two new artists, such as Picasso, Matisse, Van Gogh or Warhol being introduced weekly. You can sign your child up for all 9 weeks, or choose the number of weeks that fits your child's schedule.

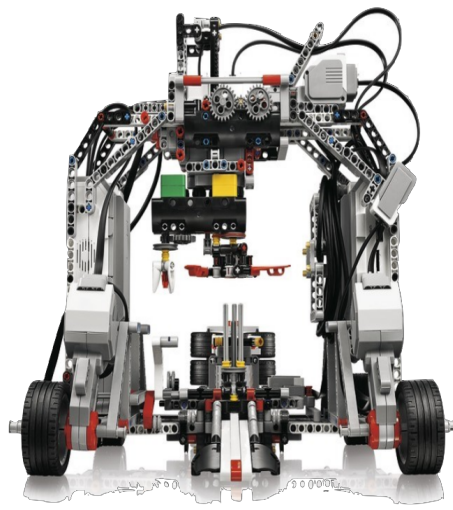
American Heritage's 2020 Musical Theatre Camp is proud to announce

They will assemble and program the Lego Mindstorm EV3 robots to overcome obstacles and compete in challenges from this year's and past years FLL competition seasons. Campers will also be able to operate a CNC machine, a 3D printer and even control our own 120 lb. FRC robot built by Stallion Robotics.

Robotics is a great way to reinforce fundamental mathematics, innovative design and the scientific process in real world situations while having fun. Campers will learn about robotics in a fun, hands-on environment with members of our award-winning robotics team. Each day they will have a free period choice outside of the Robotics Lab. At the end of each 3-week session, the campers will have tasks to complete with their robots. They will receive a certificate of achievement, acknowledging their mastery of the session objectives. Campers will bring home a special project as a final recognition of their effort.



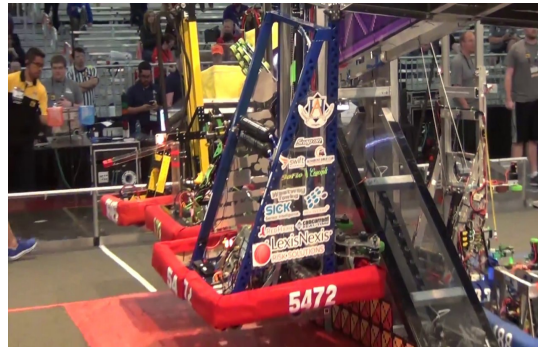

SCIENCE ADVENTURE CAMP



June 1st - July 31st 8 - 15 year olds

This camp is for the young scientist and adventurer alike. Your camper will experience hands-on lab experiments in one of our collegiate level science labs. Unique field trips and outdoor projects will be a part of the camper's weekly routine. There will be three different sessions offered, totaling nine weeks of camp. Instructing Science Adventure Camp will be our very own Science teachers from American Heritage School. They have extensive working experience with children from the ages of 8 - 15.

Session 1 (June 1 - June 19) **Exploring The Everglades and its Environment.** Learn about the Everglades ecosystem while air boating in the river of grass, coming face to face with gators, and exploring critters hiding in the shadows of the cypress wood trails.

Session 2 (June 22- July 10) **Marine Biology.** Surf the waves and paddle the currents to learn about the ocean inhabitants that lurk above and below the surface.

Session 3 (July 13- JULY 31) **Weird and Wacky Science.** Learn about the weird and wacky world of science with awesome chemical reactions, exploding physical changes, and catapulting adventures.
