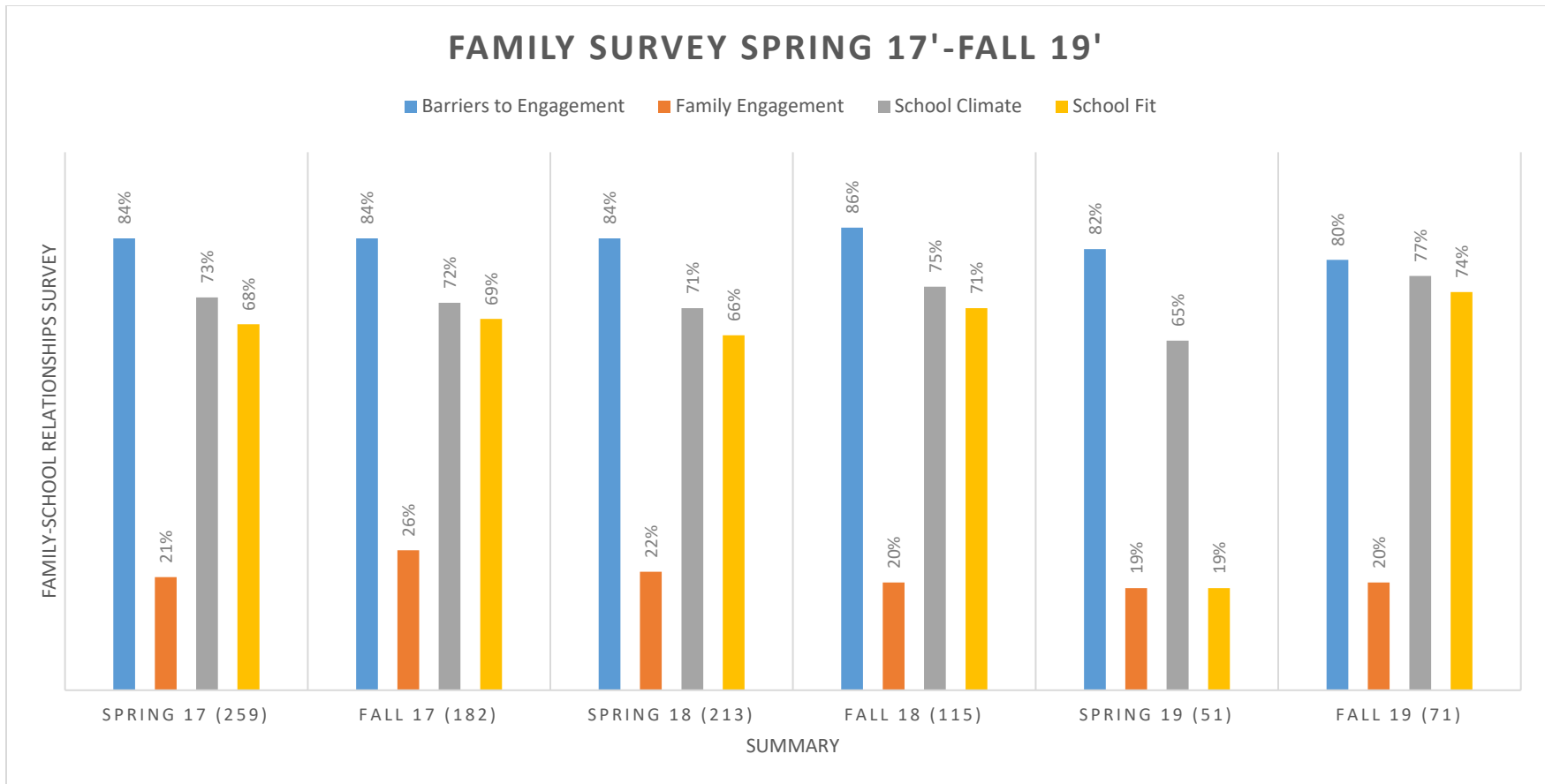


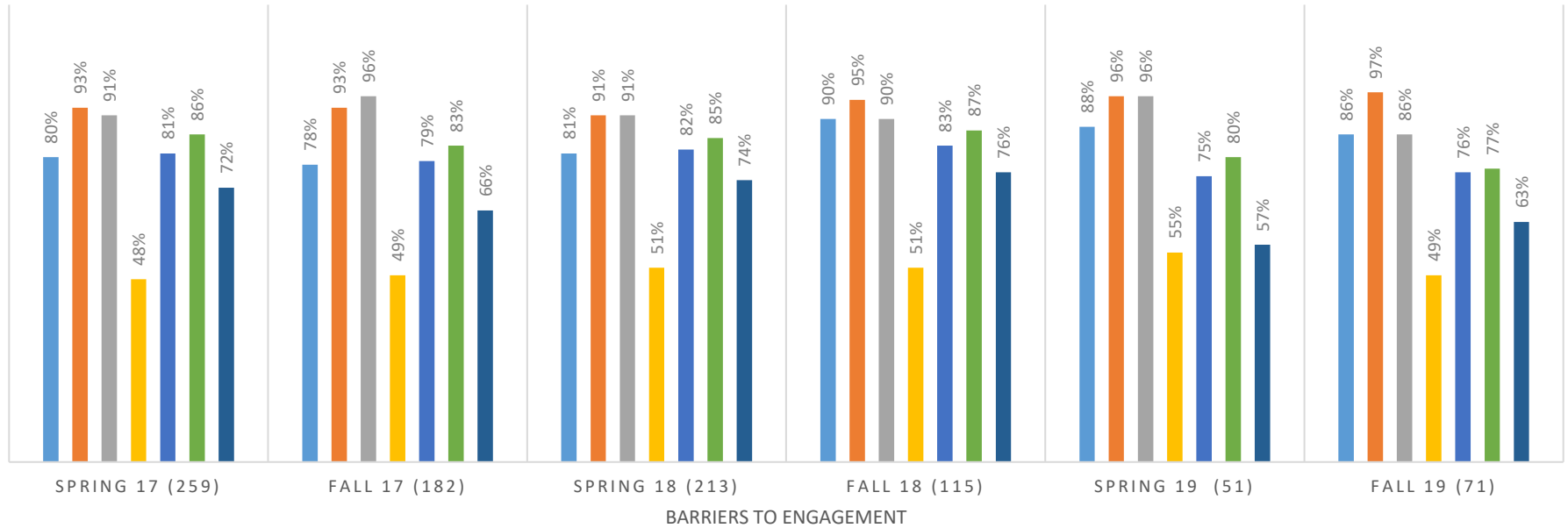
## FAMILY SURVEY SPRING 17'-FALL 19'
