



Archbishop Hannan High School 2020 Alumni Legacy Scholarship Application

The Archbishop Hannan Alumni Legacy Scholarship is a one-time scholarship given to a Senior Legacy at Archbishop Hannan High School. The purpose of this scholarship is to recognize students who are continuing the Hannan legacy and tradition in their families, are in good academic standing, and are involved in the Hannan community.

1. Scholarship: \$1,000.00 for tuition assistance
2. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Please type or print legibly.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be a graduating Senior Legacy student. Student must have a parent, stepparent, or grandparent who is a graduate of Archbishop Hannan High School.
- Applicants must have a minimum AHHS Cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Applicants must be applying as a full time student at a college, university, or trade school program for the upcoming academic semester.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form (Deadline: March 16, 2020)
- Archbishop Hannan High School Transcripts
- Proof of acceptance or enrollment at an academic, vocational or technical school for post-secondary studies (i.e. letter of acceptance from the college or university or proof of application)
- A minimum 500 word typed essay on one of the two following topics:
 - 1) *Archbishop Philip M. Hannan left a legacy behind of charity, compassion and service. He was an integral part of our school opening in St. Bernard Parish in 1987, and his motto “Caritas Vinculum Perfectionis” became our school motto. Archbishop Hannan’s legacy lives on not only in the mission and vision of our school, but in the faculty and students as well. What legacy are you leaving behind as you plan to graduate from Hannan?*
 - 2) *Our Alma Mater says, “Like the trees our roots grow deep.” As the second generation of Hawks to walk these hallways, your family’s roots have grown deeper into the Hannan community. How has being a Legacy influenced your experience at Hannan, and how will you ensure your roots continue to grow?*

SELECTION PROCESS

- Applications are submitted by the deadline.
- The AHHS Alumni Association Scholarship Committee will nominate 3 candidates for interviews.
- The top 3 applicants will be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee. The committee will then vote. (3 pts for 1st, 2 pts for 2nd, 1 pt for 3rd)
- The scholarship recipient will be chosen based on their essay and highest total number of votes received.
- Recipient will be announced at Baccalaureate Mass, funds will be awarded upon proof of college enrollment.
