Online Registration for SBA Summer Play Days is OPEN!

SBA Summer Play Days is a summer program that allows students ages 4-12 the opportunity to create a unique experience each week through a variety of activities. Students are able to enjoy different themes, visitors, art projects, games, and a water day each week. Additionally this year, Summer Play Days is excited to explore a variety of academic, athletic, and enrichment camps each week.

<u>Hours</u>: Summer Play Days is open from 8am - 6pm Monday through Friday. Camps are offered at various times throughout the week. See more information below.

<u>Registration</u>: Online registration is available <u>here</u>, or through the SBA website. **Registration is not considered complete unless it has been paid in full online or a deposit has been received**. All registrations will be confirmed via email. If your child does not currently attend SBA, please provide an updated copy of your child's immunization record.

<u>Cost</u>: Each week of Summer Play Days is \$260 (discount available to camp participants). A daily rate of \$70 is available, but advance notice **is required**. A deposit of \$50 will be required of each registrant and will be applied to the payment for the first week. Prices of additional camps can be found next to the camp description below. A deposit of \$50 will be required for each camp and will be applied to the camp total. Weekly fees should be paid on Monday of the week your child(ren) attends. Students may not participate in their next week until all fees are paid. All payments can be made in cash or checks made payable to SBA.

Late Fee: If a child is picked up after 6:00pm, a late fee of \$5 per minute per child will be applied to the weekly total.

<u>Deadlines</u>: Summer Play Days accepts registrations throughout the summer, however the Director must be notified <u>no later than the Friday before each week</u> in order to meet staff to child ratios. The deadline for all June camps will be Friday, May 1. The deadline to register for all July camps will be Friday, June 5. <u>There will be no walk-ins allowed</u>.

Lunch: Summer Play Days will provide a morning and an afternoon snack. Students should bring a lunch each day.

T-Shirts: Every child that registers with Summer Play Days by June 12 will receive a t-shirt!

<u>Drop off/Pick up</u>: Drop off and pick up will be at the back of the school in the dining hall. If you follow the driveway to the right of the Bernard entrance between the two buildings, the school will be on your left and the road will bend to the left into a parking lot. Please use the glass double doors off of the courtyard near the playground.

<u>Electronics</u>: Electronic devices will be allowed for thirty minutes in the morning and in the afternoon. Children may use their devices to listen to music, read a book, or play a game. Devices will not be used for movies, texting, social media, etc.
