COLLEGE 101 MODEL



The academic model for College 101 is designed to give high school students a first-hand college experience. Here's how:

- Students take a customized, six-week summer course for three college credits. Classes are 90-minute morning sessions, four days a week. Past courses include, but are not limited to: Introduction to Business, Introduction to Criminal Justice, and Introduction to Mobile Application Development.
- Each cohort will have a Fisher College student who serves as the designated Peer Mentor. Peer Mentors act as a resource for fellow students to ask questions about Fisher, and their academic work.
- Students who successfully complete the summer course may register for one Fisher College course during both the Fall and Spring semesters of their high school senior year.
- As a result, students benefit from the opportunity to network with Fisher faculty, staff, and students. They make career advancing connections with colleagues and with students from other high schools.

HUGE SAVINGS, INCREDIBLE VALUE



Fisher is committed to providing a fully-funded enrichment experience to high school students. A typical 3-credit course at Fisher College is valued at \$3,000 - our College 101 program provides students with the opportunity to take three courses, each for three college credits, with books included, at absolutely no cost.

The credits a student earns through College 101 may be applied to a college education at Fisher, giving a student a head start on an education that is relevant in today's economy. Credits may also be transferred to other institutions. This means that participating in College 101 is a financial savings of nearly \$10,000!

Upon completion of the College 101 program, students who elect to attend Fisher College after graduating from high school are awarded the \$20,000 College 101 Scholarship. This is a renewable award given to students in addition to any institutional, federal, or state aid for which they may qualify.
