



### The Big Picture With Fr. Bob



### Dear Friends,

Within the last week, I have been very moved by both our  $8^{th}$  graders and by the seminarians from Sacred Heart Major Seminary. The  $8^{th}$  graders were partaking in a retreat as part of their preparation for receiving the sacrament of Confirmation. The seminarians were participating in a Desert Meal, a wonderful gathering held in order to help support the seminarians who will be going on pilgrimage to the Holy

Land this Spring. (Dominic Raona also wrote an article for this week's bulletin concerning the Desert Meal on page 12.)

In both cases, the 8<sup>th</sup> graders and the seminarians had opportunities to share part of their faith journey. In some circles, we would call that sharing their witness. Others would simply say it is witnessing to what God has done in their life.

When someone shares a part of their own story, several things take place. First, you come to know that person on a deeper level. Second, we may be surprised by the beautiful and sometimes amazing ways in which God has worked in someone's life. Third, God's loving actions in someone else's life can give us hope. We might start to think, "If God did that for them, maybe God will provide for me in my struggles."

We probably all heard people say that politics and religion are two topics that should not be discussed. Well, it is pretty hard to follow the call of Jesus for us to go forth and make disciples of all nations if we don't have discussions that center around religion.

Nonetheless, there are many topics that come under the heading of "Religion." Some of those conversations could end in a heated, unproductive argument. However, when someone shares from their heart how God has been at work, wonderful things can happen. I have never known of a heated, ugly argument resulting from someone humbly sharing how God has lovingly been at work in their life.

Sharing our story when we feel the Holy Spirit is nudging us can bring light, hope, and consolation, and more into another person's life.

Some people share stories that are truly miraculous. We may think that we do not have anything really dramatic to share. Sometimes, people need just a little encouragement to keep going in the right direction. Your simple witness might be just what they need.

God is so good! If we quiet ourselves, I am sure that each of us will be able to recognize ways in which Jesus has lovingly intervened in our lives. Just last Sunday at Mass, we heard proclaimed:

You are the light of the world.

A city set on a mountain cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and then put it under a bushel basket; It is set on a lampstand, where it gives light to all in the house. Just so, your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds

and glorify your heavenly Father."

Matthew 5:14-16

Yes, we are called to be the light of the world!

In simple ways, our actions accompanied by our faith sharing, our witness, can help bring people who are spiritually or emotionally running on empty, closer to Jesus. The truth is, we all find ourselves running on empty from time to time. May we be both humble and courageous enough to let our witness touch the hearts of others who are in need of hearing those life-giving words.

Every person between the age of 18 and 59 (beginning of 60th year) must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

- Use your hunger to focus more clearly on Christ, every time your stomach rumbles think about how hungry Jesus must've been during His forty days in the desert. How hungry was He while hanging on the cross. Allow it to become a prayerful exercise.
- Every person **14 years of age or older** must abstain from meat (and items made with meat) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and every Friday during Lent.
- Every person between the **age of 18 and 59** (beginning of 60th year) must **fast** on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. When **fasting**, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are <u>not equal</u> to a full meal, according to Canon law & the U.S. Bishops.

DCES 6th grader James Townsel was recognized in a news story for academic excellence and leadership skills on FOX 2 News.



### **DC PARISHIONERS HELP** FOLEY KNIGHTS SUPPORT DESERT MEAL

Last Sunday, 40 Divine Child parishioners and Foley Knights and their families filled four tables at Crystal Gardens Banquet Center in Southgate. A total of 380 people came out to support the Downriver KofC Desert Dinner to support seminarians on their pilgrimage to the Holy Land. The Bernard P. O'Brien Council #3956 hosted the more than ten different councils that help support this annual event.

Twenty seminarians were in attendance to visit with the guests and give testimony to their call to the priesthood. With the help of donations collected from the guests, these seminarians will make their pilgrimage to the Holy Land in the near future. During the presentation, they played a video from Sacred Heart Major Seminary that depicted seminarians who visited the Holy Land in the past. The seminarians in the video, who are now priests, witnesses as to how their trip to the Holy Land would help them be better priests. To know that they are walking on the same ground as Jesus did, to participate in Holy Mass on the shores of the Sea of Galilee where Jesus called His apostles or to have said Mass right next to where Jesus died on the cross. These experiences can only leave a positive mark on the spirits of these young men who will be the shepherds of our future flocks. I think everyone who attended was excited to hear from these young men and even more excited for the journey they are about to embark upon.

The Knights of Columbus work tirelessly to support and defend our priests. From the highest level: the Knights give the Pope \$1 million dollars annually to give to the charities of his choice and foster the RSVP program that encourages individual councils to support seminarians and religious with their educational needs.
