## Transition to Work Training

**The Misericordia Autism Center will be providing transition services that include the following curriculum options:**

- ◆ Self advocacy
- ◆ Life Skills for Independent Living
- ◆ Career Choices and Development
- ◆ Job Placement and Maintenance Care

**Within each domain, the transition specialist will provide:**

- ◆ Hands-on learning activities
- ◆ Role-playing
- ◆ Reinforcement of learned and newly acquired skills
- ◆ Peer and teacher modeling
- ◆ Social stories

**In addition to the various projects, worksheets and planned activities, the student/specialist will engage in meaningful dialogue throughout each session. Specific topics include:**

- ◆ Understanding the environment and how it affects us
- ◆ Disability awareness
- ◆ Communication
- ◆ Writing resumes
- ◆ Preparing for job interviews
- ◆ Time management
- ◆ Career options
- ◆ Multitude of independent living skills

These are some examples of what the students will be learning throughout the sessions. Each individual will meet and/or exceed measurable outcomes through participation and progress monitoring. It is our hope that you take full advantage of this transition to work training by enrolling your child.
