

## MHS COUNTDOWN INFORMATION for SENIORS

### Class of 2020

COLLEGE	Texas public schools (colleges, universities, technical institutes) require that you take the THEA (Texas Higher Education Assessment) test unless you meet the current exemption criteria.
FEES	Your final transcript will be held if you have any outstanding debts (Chromebook and charger; library fines; lost textbooks; equipment, lab, gym or other fees)
TRANSCRIPTS	The final transcript card that you receive in your Senior Advisory class in April will need to be completed and returned to the registrar. This will determine what school will receive your final grades and verification of graduation. If you college decision changes after that, notify the registrar immediately.

### IMPORTANT DATES

Feb 19	Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) testing – See your counselor if interested.
Feb 24 - March 6	AP Test Registration online for 2nd Semester courses only – see MHS website
Feb 28	Balfour picking up payments for cap/gown orders in cafeteria during both lunches CASH ONLY If you miss this date you must order online (www.balfour.com) or at 1221 Lumpkin, Suite A Orders after March 1 will be charged a late fee.
March 23-26	TSI testing in the MPR – your counselor will notify you if you need to take this test
March 30 - April 9	Prom tickets are FREE to MHS Seniors. ALL Seniors must complete and sign a Code of Behavior form online by April 5 to attend prom (check SBISD e-mail). All guests that are not MHS Seniors must purchase a ticket for \$20 and guests must have a signed behavior form on file. Tickets and forms for guests are available in G-201.
April 9	Your Code of Behavior for Graduation and Prom must be completed online. You must be logged in to your school google account to use the form.
April 9	Complete final transcript card in Advisory.
April 17	Senior Prom - 8 pm to Midnight - Rice Hotel (909 Texas Ave) Doors will be open at 8:00 pm. Students will not be allowed to enter the prom after 9:30 pm. Students who leave will not be readmitted.
April - TBA	Graduation announcements ordered from Balfour will be delivered to address on order form
May 1	Caps, gowns, and graduation seating assignments will be issued during 5/6 lunch. The Code of Behavior form must be completed online, all fees paid, all detentions, and attendance made up (ALA hours) before the cap and gown may be picked up.
May 4 - 15	Advanced Placement exams - specific dates will be posted on the MHS website
May 12 - students @ 6pm	Senior Awards Night - Auditorium - Students due at 6 pm; program starts 6:30 - invitations will be sent to specific students
May 19 - May 22	Senior Final Exams. The specific schedule will be posted on the MHS website.
May 20 - 1 PM	Graduation Rehearsal - Attendance is required. Students must report to the Coliseum at 1:00 pm. In the interest of time, it is extremely important to be prompt and to find your assigned seat immediately. Park on the east side of Tully and enter the coliseum through the tarmac.
May 15	All detention hours and ALA hours must be completed in order to participate in graduation exercises. Attendance - Any senior who is required to make up hours to the state for excessive absences (ALA hours) must do so by Friday, May 15.
May 23 - Student check in - 9 AM	Graduation - Don Coleman Coliseum, 10 AM Students must check in at 9 am. BE ON TIME. Only students who have fulfilled all graduation requirements may participate in the ceremony. There is no limit on the number of guests. Parking - You must park at Stratford High School or the East side of Tully.
