at Wilder-Waite

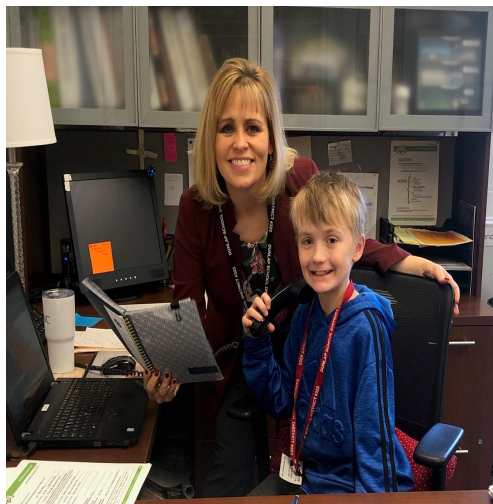


If you, or anyone you know in our district, have a 5 year old child, you will need to pre-register online through www.dunlapcusd.net/registration. The window is open until midnight on February 23rd. On Tuesday you should bring 3 proofs of residency, and an **original certified** birth certificate. The registration fee of \$140.00 can be paid online or at school during the registration. Checks made payable to Dunlap School District. You may also bring any health records. Prior to the first day of school, we require a current Illinois school physical form, a record of immunizations, a current dental exam, and a current eye exam.
