Sebastian Hess is one of the most multi-faceted musicians of his generation. His musical activities span from a passion for historically informed performance on baroque cello and the classical and romantic periods to a close-knit collaboration with some of the leading composers of our time, including Jörg Widmann, Wolfgang Rihm, Rodion Shchedrin, Mikis Theodorakis and especially Hans Werner Henze.

Among his many musical endeavors as solo performer, teacher, artistic director and composer, by invitation of the Royal Court of Spain and **HRH Juan Carlos I.**, Sebastian Hess performs bi-annually in the Palacio Real in Madrid on the Stradivarius cellos from the Royal Collection. Hess is a recording artist for most European broadcasting networks. He has worked and studied with many great artists including William Pleeth, Mstislav Rostropovich, and Bernhard Greenhouse.
