## RULES

- Rules of competition and conduct per FIBA regulations except:
- All games shall be 2 x 14-minute running halves with a three-minute halftime. There shall be no overtime periods.
- No shot clock
- One timeout per team per half.
- Players shall be dismissed from the game after four (4) fouls.
- On the 7th team foul the penalty is in effect.
- Person to person defence only, zone defences are not permitted.
- Half court press only permitted with the exception that a full court press may be used in the last two minutes of the game.
- There will be no limit to squad size for Jamboree, but only 12 players may be entered into the scorebook prior to the start of each game and those 12 only may be used in that one game.
- Running clock except stopped clock on all free throws and timeouts. The clock shall also stop after all baskets and violations during the final minute of the game.
- Teams should be ready to take the court immediately following any preceding match with a five-minute warm-up period.
