- Ryan Van Natter shared the data on middle-of-year Acadience (DIBELS) testing. Our SIP goal was that we would increase the percentage of students proficient from beginning of year to middle of year by 10. We increased by 8, not quite meeting our goal. We will continue to work to meet the 10 point increase by the end of the year.
- We discussed the recent requirement for volunteers to be background checked, along with the information that the cost had been reduced from \$40 to \$28. PTA is working on a proposal to help fund the checks for parents whose involvement in PTA is significant.
