2. Review and Approve January Minutes
  - a. January minutes approved
3. Updates- Principal McDonough
  - a. Digital Citizenship
    - i. Digital Citizenship document was reviewed
    - ii. Discussed funding of home-use computers for kids in need
  - b. Teacher Survey Results and Feedback
    - i. Unanimous support for funding reading aides
    - ii. For academic area focus: Language Arts 7 votes, math 11 votes, science 1 vote
    - iii. Satisfied with I-Ready: no- 9 votes, yes- 7 votes
    - iv. Interest in Ready Math: no- 8, yes- 3, maybe- 7
      1. Ready Math would be supplemental to I-Ready
    - v. Willingness to have extra responsibilities: yes- 9, no- 9
      1. Teachers earn stipends for using NearPod or reading a book
    - vi. NearPod license yes- 9, no- 9
    - vii. InfiniD Lab yes 13-, no- 4
    - viii. Summer reading group no- 4, yes- 11 (teachers reading group)
    - ix. SIP Priority goals LA- 4 votes, aides, math- 6 votes, technology, after school tutoring
    - x. Technology Training: NearPod- 3, social/emotional, canvas- 3, more of it & exposure to what we can use, One Note, Website, Support for Essential Elements kids, apple tv (2), Writable
  - c. School report card
    - i. Proficiency: making typical growth- LA 47%, Math 47.8%, Science 43.8%.
    - ii. Overall, we had a decrease of the percentage of students who score proficient from the previous year in all areas. However, growth is the focus over proficiency.
    - iii. Student Growth- LA 37.3%, math 34.6%, science 50.6%, growth of lowest 25% is 61.7%
    - iv. English Learner Progress- adequate progress 53.3%, Reaching proficiency 6.7%

- v. Early literacy- reading on grade level 53%, making typical or better progress 64%
- vi. Acadience reading goal is 80%
  - 1. K-3 Proficiency: 65% at benchmark, pathways of progress is 65% typical or above growth
  - 2. K-6 Proficiency: 66% at benchmark, progress is 68% typical or above average growth
  - 3. Kingeraten MOY 49% at benchmark, 45% typical or above average growth
  - 4. 1<sup>st</sup> grade MOY 65% at benchmark, 76% typical or above average growth
  - 5. 2<sup>nd</sup> grade MOY 55% at benchmark, 58% typical or above average growth
  - 6. 3<sup>rd</sup> grade MOY 76% at benchmark, 75% typical or above average growth
  - 7. 4<sup>TH</sup> grade MOY 64% at benchmark, 79% typical or above average growth
  - 8. 5<sup>th</sup> grade MOY 71% at benchmark, 63% typical or above average growth
  - 9. 6<sup>th</sup> grade MOY 89% at benchmark, 80% typical or above average growth
