Middle School Parent & Student *Consent Form* for Full-Year (*optional*) Spanish Course

In order to determine if you are prepared for the expectations of a full-year HIGH SCHOOL level course, please read the following statements:

- ✓ I understand that all middle school Spanish courses are high school level courses. The pace and rigor will be fast and challenging for the average 7th grade student.
- ✓ I understand that the grade I earn in the course *will be included in my high school transcript and cumulative Grade Point Average.*
- ✓ I already know that Spanish interests me, and I am committed to the Spanish language.
- ✓ I understand that I will be required to pass a Spanish language proficiency exam in order to advance to the next level of Spanish language study.
- ✓ I am dedicated to studying on a daily basis and am prepared for the rigor of high school level work.
- ✓ I plan to take five to six consecutive years of the Spanish language, or I plan to learn multiple languages, or I have already had experience learning the Spanish language.
- ✓ My goal is to work towards fluency in Spanish.
- ✓ I understand that the full-year Spanish language course will take the place of one hour of an Elective course both semesters.

Other things to Note for the Middle School student considering taking Spanish:

- ✓ If you do not desire to take more than two years of a world language, taking world language courses later in your high school career will better prepare you for success on college placement exams.
- ✓ Enrolling in advanced levels of Spanish *may* require the student travel to another building.
- ✓ Enrollment in a Spanish class *may* impact the lunch period for students.
- ✓ These classes *may* be in a multi-grade class setting.
