### STUDENT ID REMINDERS

For your children's safety, students are required to wear their IDs at all times during school hours. They only take them off during Physical Education. IDs are also required to receive a hot lunch and to check out library books. If a student does not have their ID for hot lunch, they are asked to stand at the end of the line, as to not hold up the lunch line.

Student IDs are to remain in student lockers after school. They are not to be taken home for any reason. Every day that a student does not have their ID on them, they will be asked to call home. If the ID is lost or broken, replacement IDs are \$5. If your child needs a new lanyard only, they are \$2.



As the weather starts to get warmer, we want to remind students that the following items of clothing are not permitted:

- Fashion or materials, which exaggerate, emphasize, reveal or call attention to anatomical details, or expose undergarments
- Torn or cut articles of clothing
- Sleeveless shirts, mesh shirts, or biker shorts
