904 PUBLIC ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL EVENTS

Purpose

The Board welcomes the public at activities and events sponsored by the District and designated as open to the public. The Board also acknowledges its duty to maintain order and protect District facilities during such events.

Authority

The Board has the authority to prohibit at a school event the attendance of any individual whose conduct may constitute a disruption. Disruptive, and therefore, prohibited conduct includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- discrimination/harassment/incivility;
- gambling;
- tobacco use;
- the possession or use of controlled substances on school premises;
- the possession or use of alcoholic beverages on school premises;
- the possession or use of weapons on school premises;
- activities that may endanger the health, safety, and wellness of others; and,
- activities prohibited in other Board policies.

Violators of these prohibitions or any other applicable Board Policy will be considered trespassers.

Guidelines

The Superintendent or designee shall prepare a schedule of fees for activities that is reasonable and enhances public attendance.

Delegation of Responsibility

The Board directs the Superintendent to develop an Administrative Regulation implementing this Policy.
