# Additional Compensation Opportunities

# Leadership Compensation:

Faculty in positions of leadership that coordinate others and/or support the operational or curricular needs of the school are eligible to receive an additional annual salary adjustment.

### Stipends:

Faculty dedicating time as an advisor for teams, clubs, or groups, that require practice, competition, summer duties, performance or publication are eligible for additional stipends.

## Other Unique Benefits:

- Reimbursing teacher licensure testing and application fees with faculty commitments
- Up to \$2,500 tuition reimbursement annually
- Wellness incentive reimbursement (25% of wellness costs, up to \$100 annually)
