1. <u>School Presentations - Lincoln Elementary and Central Middle School</u>. Principals Dan Schmidt and Cathryn Peterson presented updates regarding strategic initiatives at their schools.

2. <u>American Indian Parent Advisory Update</u>. Jordan Zickermann, Native American Cultural Liaison and Indian Education Program Lead, provided an update on the work of the American Indian Parent Advisory Committee (AIPAC). Zickermann will be joined by the AIPAC chairperson at the March 2 Regular School Board Meeting for a formal presentation of the AIPAC's resolution vote of concurrence or non- concurrence.
