Board Expands Student Services Support

Across the nation, children are experiencing increased difficulties with mental health. [According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\)](#), anxiety and behavior disorders are among the more commonly diagnosed mental disorders in childhood. As a result of the increasing social-emotional needs in our schools, the Board approved an expansion of the social work and psychological services team at the elementary and junior high levels to ensure students have access to staff when the need arises.

In addition, the Board approved an Alternative Program at Lisle High School to provide an additional layer of support for students struggling behaviorally and/or with credit recovery. This program will be an in-house program that is designed to try to prevent major suspensions, expulsions or outplacements by providing students the opportunity to continue to build positive relationships and receive the academic and social-emotional support needed to work to avoid find success and graduate high school within their home-school setting (and is unrelated to special education programming).

Tate Woods School Sale Update

The Board of Education approved a second amendment to the purchase and sale agreement for Tate Woods School. The purchaser, Kindi Academy, requested to reduce the minimum number of days notice prior to the May 1, 2020 closing date to terminate the contract from sixty (60) to thirty (30) days. They requested the modification to allow the Village of Lisle to vote on the required Special Use Permit for the purchased building on March 16, 2020.
