- School Improvement Plan goals and initial funding

- School Improvement Planning Day March 13th, will need final vote on budget by March 25th

- Five Target Goals for Funding

1. Increase the percent proficient in core areas by 2% on RISE and ASPIRE tests and CTE competency assessments .

2. Maintain the number of students who are credit deficient to less than 5%

3. Teachers will function as DCTs that will work collaboratively to identify collective goals, develop strategies to achieve those goals, gather relevant data, and learn from one another.

4. Increase the effective use of technology in instruction by showing an increase with the following two measures: increase the percent of “evident (or higher) ratings on Evaluate Davis System in technology and learning by 2% and Increase the stakeholders’ surveys ratings on technology and learning to meet or exceed the DSD averages.

5. Establish SEL program for students that reflects 2% growth from pre to post survey.
