Dear Parents, Students, and Staff,

We wish to proactively protect our students and staff at Resurrection College Prep High School from possible exposure to not only the **Coronavirus** but to all respiratory viruses and strains of influenza, therefore we are initiating the following policy as of March 3, 2020:


1. Any student or staff member presenting with the following symptoms will be sent home immediately and will be asked for a note from a doctor before returning to school:
  - a. Fever
  - b. Cough
  - c. Shortness of breath
  - d. Sore Throat
2. Even if a student or staff member has been cleared of having Coronavirus (or other respiratory virus) by a physician the student or staff member will not be allowed to return to school until they are free of fever (100 degree Fahrenheit) for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications (CDC recommendation for all people with influenza-like symptoms).
3. If your student is home with flu-like symptoms, please contact the school attendance office and leave a detailed message indicating the symptoms.


We also want to share with you that our provider of food services at Resurrection College Prep High School, Quest, has developed and committed to a strong policy for their staff to follow which supports the school's policies.

We will continue to watch for guidance and updates from CDC and our local and State Boards of Health. We pray that everyone stays healthy and that a resolution to this virus will be found soon.
