**Ansonia High School**

Community: Settled in 1889, Ansonia serves a community of 19,249 people over an area of 6.2 square miles which is included in the Lower Naugatuck Valley in New Haven County. Ansonia is known as “The Copper City” recognizing its rich history of heavy machine manufacturing industry.

School: The town of Ansonia hosts one high school, one middle school, and two elementary schools.

Rank in Class and GPA: Grade point average and class rank reflect the academic achievement of all students during their enrollment at Ansonia High School. All courses are included in the computation with the exception of those graded on a pass/fail basis. Honors, AP, and Dual Credit College classes are weighted additional points for ranking. Only students who have been enrolled as active students at Ansonia High School for a minimum of two complete school years (8 terms / 4 semesters), shall be included in the top ten ranking of their class

Curricula: Ansonia High School boasts a comprehensive high school program with sequential courses available in all college preparatory subjects as well as in art, music, business and technology. Twenty – two credits including physical education, computer applications and successful completion of the SAT are required for graduation.
