### Full Year Elective Options

- Band 1-Brass (2204)** For beginning students who want to play a brass instrument. Instruments are available to rent. (Evening performances required) (Fee)
- Band 1-Woodwind (2205)** For beginning students who want to play a woodwind instrument. Instruments are available to rent. (Evening performances required) (Fee)
- Band 2-Brass/Woodwinds (2210)** Intermediate band for brass and woodwind instruments (evening performances required) (Tryouts) (Fee)
- Band 2-Percussion (2213)** Intermediate band for percussion. (Evening performances required) (Tryouts) (Fee)
- Band 3-Advanced (2220)** The top band for brass and woodwind. (Evening performances required) (Tryouts) (Fee)
- Chimes (2306)** Students will learn and perform in a hand chime group. Prerequisite: 2+ years of piano lessons or chime experience (evening performances required). (Fee)
- Chinese 1 (3310)** Beginning class that will introduce the Chinese language, culture, and history. (Fee)
- Chinese 2 (3320)** More emphasis on reading, writing and Chinese speaking. Further exploration into Chinese culture. (Fee)
- Choir 2-Knight Lights (2307)** An intermediate choir for boys and girls (evening performances required) (Fee)
- Choir 3 – A Capella (2310)** Advanced choir for boys and girls specializing in a capella style music. (Tryouts) (Fee)
- Choir 3-Knightingales (2310)** Advanced show choir for girls with treble voices. Some extra & evening performances required (Tryouts) (Fee)
- Choir 3 – Choraliers (2310)** Advanced show choir for boys and girls. (Some extra and evening performances required) (Tryouts) (Fee)
- Dance Company (2606)** Performing dance group will focus on choreography and technique. Extra performances required. (Tryouts) (Fee)
- French 1 (3210)** Beginning class that will introduce the French language, culture, and history. (Fee)
- French 2 (3220)** Extension from French 1. French 1 prerequisite. (Fee)
- Orchestra 1 (2405)** For beginning students who want to play a string instrument (evening performances required). Pre-requisite: 6<sup>th</sup> grade class or private lessons are strongly encouraged. (Evening performances required) (Fee)
- Orchestra 2 (2406)** Advanced orchestra. (Evening performances required) Prerequisite: Orchestra 1. (Fee)
- Spanish 1 (3110)** Beginning class that will introduce the Spanish language, culture, and history. (Fee)
- Spanish 2 (3120)** Extension from Spanish 1. Spanish 1 prerequisite. This is not a class for students who already speak Spanish. (Fee)
- Yearbook (4365)** Students will help produce the school yearbook.

### Semester or Year Elective Options

- Counseling Assistant (212)** Help the counselors as needed. (Counselor permission required)
- Library Media Assistant (215)** Help in the library as needed. (Librarian permission required)
- Office Assistant (210)** Help in the office as needed. (Secretary permission required)
- Peer Tutor (213)** Assist a specific teacher by helping a student or group of students understand concepts and assignments. (Teacher permission required)
- Peer Tutor Functional Skills (213)** Assist Functional Skills teacher to help students with disabilities. (Teacher permission required)
- Teacher Assistant (211)** Help a specific teacher as needed. (Teacher permission required)
- ACT Prep (400)** This class will give students an opportunity to learn critical thinking skills, as well as do homework, study, and get teacher help.
- Choir 1-Beginning Choir (2301)** A beginning choir for boys and girls. (Evening performances required) (Fee)

### Semester Elective Options

- 3-D Art (2104)** Students will design and create a variety of 3-D art, NO prerequisite required. (Fee)
- Advanced Art (2103)** This class will continue to build knowledge and skill of art elements, mediums, and history. Prerequisite: Art Foundations 1. (Fee)
- Art Foundations 1 (2101)** A basic art class covering a wide variety of art elements, mediums, and history. (Fee)
- Beginning Drawing (2101)** Learning basics of drawing such as shading, form, use of space and perspective. (Fee)
- Beginning Ukulele (2316)** Introduces basic ukulele technique. Students must provide their own ukulele.
- Creative Coding (7743)** Introductory course with activities such as creating and organizing web pages, designing mobile apps; and collaboratively developing, publishing, and presenting products such as videos and podcasts. (Fee)
- Creative Writing 1 (4335)** Teaches the skills and strategies necessary to write creatively.
- Current Issues (4531)** Students will explore local, national, and international issues. May be taken once per school year.
- Dance 1 (2601)** A dance class for all genders and levels. No dance experience required. (Ballet, Jazz, Contemporary)
- Dance 2 (2602)** Intermediate level dance class.
- Exploring Business & Marketing (7548)** Develop skills to become a successful entrepreneur through business marketing simulation. (Fee)
- Exploring Tech 1-Engineering (7810)** Students will learn the basics of wood construction, including making baseball bat and glove holder. (Fee)
- Exploring Tech 1-Manufacturing (7810)** Students will learn skills for design and manufacturing and make boomerangs, hot air balloons, etc. (Fee)
- FCS Exploration A (7404)** An introduction to interior design, clothing, family relationships and career related tasks. (Fee)
- FCS Exploration B (7405)** An introduction to food and nutrition, child care, entrepreneurship, career and job-related tasks. (Fee)
- Hacking STEM (6600)** Students will work with technology to learn problem-solving skills in a collaborative way.
- Keyboarding 1 (7552)** A beginning class strongly recommended for students who type less than 30 wpm.
- Musical Theatre 8-9 (2508)** For those who want to be a part of the school musical production. Mandatory evening dates – May 3-14. (Fee)
- Science Exploration-Astronomy (6701)** An introduction to the fundamental concepts of astronomy. (Fee)
- Science Exploration-Zoology (6703)** Introduction to the fundamental concepts of zoology. Dissection is required. (Fee)
- Beginning Robotics (6700)** Understanding, building and operating VEX robots. (Fee)
- Advanced Robotics (6700)** Advanced understanding, building and operating VEX robots. Prerequisite: Beginning Robotics. (Fee)
- Stage Crew/Productions (2514)** Students will help run school plays and assemblies. Some night rehearsals will be required. (Teacher permission required)
- Terrorism and the Post 9-11 World (4528)** Concepts of terrorism, modern issues, problems and solutions will be discussed. Current events will drive discussions in class.
- Theatre 1 (2502)** Students will learn to speak and perform in front of an audience.
- Theatre 2 (2503)** An advanced class for the serious drama student. Prerequisite: Theatre 1. Mandatory evening dates Nov 2-14. (Fee)
- World Wars of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century (4615)** Studying WWI, WWII and the Cold War and discuss why wars happen and the consequences.
