FAQs

1. What options are available for my child to attend kindergarten?

Parents may choose morning half-day or full-day.

2. Can I elect to change my child from half-day to full-day during the year? Full-day to half-day?

Depending upon class size and staff availability, considerations will be given on an individual basis. All requests for change must be submitted in writing to the building principal before November 1st.

3. What are the school hours of a half-day program and a full-day program?

9:05-12:00 half-day 9:05-3:15 full-day

4. Do I have a choice of AM or PM kindergarten?

No. Half-day kindergarten is AM only.

5. How will my child be transported to and from school?

District provides transportation services to and from Schilling School. Students who take the bus will be dropped off at their assigned bus stop at the end of their school day. An adult must be present at the bus stop. There will be no individual home pick-ups.

6. Where will my child attend kindergarten?

All kindergarten classes are held at Schilling School, 16025 Cedar Road, Homer Glen

7. Will a rest time be provided during the full-day program?
