### February 2020 - Creativity

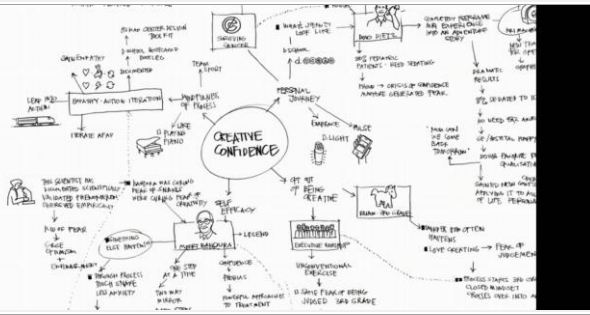
