Business Microcredential

interested in, whether that be finance, entrepreneurship, marketing or management. Students

completing the Business Microcredential, will also receive the Impact Diploma with the

need to take:

1. 0 credit Social Justice and Literature (English Credit)

1. 0 credit Mass Media and Journalism (English Credit)

1.0 credit Impact Project

Impact Project

The Impact Project is an engaging independent learning program that facilitates growth through student choice, independence and collaboration. Students inquire into passions, problems, needs, and challenges when interacting with community with the aim of developing a globally minded approach. The Impact Project is a guided extension and application of the skills, knowledge, understandings, and attitudes acquired through ISB's learning programs and values of our school. The Impact Project develops connections to and from these programs and requires transfer into unfamiliar settings.

Work Experience

Learners will engage in work experience while in the ISB Impact Program. In an authentic work environment, the learner must satisfy a role or contribute towards a project within an organization. Learners will be evaluated by the work place partner, check in with their ISB Impact Mentor and receive a certificate of completion. Work Experience will be documented in the learner's ISB Blog and a celebration of learning opportunity of their choice.
