Coding at the Middle School

The middle school Computer Science curriculum revolves around project-based learning in a highly creative fashion using Code.org's Computer Science Discoveries Course. Programming concepts learned in lower school are applied towards an openended capstone project in 6th grade. While continuing with blockly and pseudo code, students work on challenge units, which serves as a foundation. In 7th grade, students learn the basics of web design using HTML and CSS and apply that towards creating websites on a topic of their choice. Programming concepts learned in lower school and grades 6 and 7 are put to the test in 8th grade as students create animations and program games in Javascript.
