2020-2021 NON-RESIDENT Schools of Choice Application Information

For the 2020-21 school year, the Troy School District will be opening thirty (30) seats in Kindergarten, one (1) seat in 1st Grade and thirteen (13) seats for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade combined through Limited 105 (Oakland County) and 105c (contiguous intermediate school districts) placement guidelines. Please note that siblings of current Schools of Choice students receive first placements.

Application Procedures:

DO NOT BEGIN THE STUDENT ENROLLMENT PROCESS UNTIL YOU HAVE BEEN NOTIFIED OF YOUR STUDENTS ACCEPTANCE

1. Limited **applications** are being accepted to apply for our 2020-21 *Full-Day Kindergarten Program, 1st Grade and 6th, 7th and 8th Grade*. Non-Resident Applications are for NEW students to the district, NOT siblings of current Schools of Choice students (referred to as "Sibling Preference" students).
2. The buildings available for Schools of Choice students, and the number of spaces in each building, will be determined by the Troy School District.
3. If applicants exceed spaces available, a lottery will be held as specified by Michigan State Law on Thursday, April 2, 2020. Lottery results will be available within 24 hours on our district website at www.troy.k12.mi.us.
4. If a lottery is necessary, and your child's name is not initially drawn on April 2nd for admission to the Troy School District, the student's name will be maintained on a waiting list. If spots become available after the April 2nd lottery placements are made, families who were not pulled in the initial group may have another opportunity to be considered for placement. These placements will be made beginning the third Monday in August and not later than the end of the first week of school.
5. Building placement for elementary and middle school students is based on building availability.
6. Applications are screened for accurate information and may involve contacting the former school district.
7. Your acceptance is *conditional* until the Troy School District receives and reviews all school reports, if warranted.
8. The Troy School District enrollment process for the selected students will be communicated at a later date.
9. **(A) If your child is currently eligible for programs and or services such as an IEP, Speech, OT, PT, etc. and you reside outside of Oakland County, please be aware that the Troy School District is required to secure a "Special Education Cooperative Agreement" regarding reimbursement for special education costs from your resident district before enrollment is finalized.**
(B) If you reside outside of Oakland County and your child is found to be eligible for Special Education programs and/or services after admission to the Troy School District, please be advised that the district is required to obtain a "Special Education Cooperative Agreement" regarding reimbursement for special education costs from your resident district.
10. Once enrolled, students may remain in Troy Schools until graduation if the student complies with all guidelines for Schools of Choice and the Troy School District's *Student Code of Conduct and enrollment is not broken*.

ATTENDANCE:

Students are expected to arrive and depart from school on time. Students who are excessively absent or tardy may be asked to return to their home district. It is expected that parents will pick up students on time when they are attending an after school or evening event.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

All *Student Code of Conduct* rules, procedures, and policies will apply to all students who enter Troy Schools under the Schools of Choice guidelines and procedures.

BUILDING PATH ASSIGNMENT:

Every effort will be made to maintain the building path assigned when your child begins attending the Troy School District. If unforeseen circumstances occur and the need to change an assigned building path of a Schools of Choice student arises, the student may be asked to transfer to another building in the Troy School District.

TRANSPORTATION:

Parents of Schools of Choice students are expected to provide transportation to and from school, and are NOT eligible for TSD transportation services. NO EXCEPTIONS.
