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Tulsa Reconciliation Scholarship Program Nomination Form for 2020-21

The 2001 Oklahoma Legislature passed the "1921 Tulsa Race Riot Reconciliation Act of 2001" which created the Tulsa Reconciliation Education and Scholarship Program. In 2002 the Legislature further authorized each Tulsa Public High School to nominate up to two high school seniors meeting certain eligibility criteria. These scholarships are intended to help preserve awareness of the history and meaning of the civil unrest that occurred in Tulsa in 1921. Upon approval by the State Regents for Higher Education, the nominees will be eligible to receive a one-time scholarship award of \$1,000 to be used at an accredited Oklahoma college or public post-secondary career technology center.
