Welcome back to school! The Princeton Public School District looks forward to a productive partnership with you to ensure the success of all of our students. Two of the systems we will be using to keep you informed throughout the year are PowerSchool Learning and our Parent Portal. As we start the school year, there are a few important updates and reminders that we want to share with you about these systems.

[PowerSchool Learning](#)

PowerSchool Learning was a new tool that we introduced last year to enhance communication between teachers, students, and parents. This year, teachers will be integrating PowerSchool Learning more thoroughly into their classes. As appropriate for each grade level, this year, teachers will be using PowerSchool Learning to:

- Post homework assignments in a timely manner with reasonable due dates
- Post long-term assignments in a timely manner with reasonable due dates
- Provide a calendar listing test dates and assignment due dates as soon as they are scheduled
- Share newsletters, syllabi, links to resources, etc.

During the first week of school, teachers will show students, as developmentally appropriate, how to login and access their class website in PowerSchool Learning.

The Parent Portal allows parents to check their students' grades, track their students' attendance, and update their contact information.

Due to a system update for PowerSchool Learning, all families will be receiving new login information in an email prior to the start of the school year. You should **no longer** use your previously created PowerSchool Learning login. If you received PowerSchool Learning login information this summer, please disregard that information and look for the updated login information that will be sent to you next week.

Parent Portal

Your Parent Portal login will remain the same as last year. If you do not have a Parent Portal Account, you will receive instructions for setting up a Parent Portal account in the PowerSchool Learning email that will be sent to you next week.
