IRISH COME BACK TO GET VICTORY OVER CLAWSON

The Notre Dame Girls Varsity Basketball team picked up a 60-56 overtime win over Clawson in MHSAA District Tournament play. After trailing by as many as 10 in the first half, the Irish cut the deficit to two as the Trojans took a 27-25 lead into halftime on a basket at the buzzer. After an even third quarter, which saw Clawson take a 43-40 lead, Notre Dame still found themselves down late in the contest. The Irish battled back, tying the score at 54-54 with 14 second left to force an overtime period. Notre Dame would outscore Clawson 6-2 in the extra time to come away with the win. The Irish were led by a balanced offensive attack. Malorie Wilson had 14 points while Abby Wichers and Justina Gaynor each had 11. Elena Schwegman chipped in with eight, Kaitlyn Jansen and Jenna Schultz had six and Lauren Lopez had four. Notre Dame now advances to the District Final where they will take on Cranbrook.

CARRIER REACHES INDIVIDUAL FINALS

At the MHSAA Girls Bowling Individual Regional tournament, Notre Dame Senior Theresa Carrier took fourth place out of 59 participants to earn a spot in the State Final meet. Carrier bowled games on 157, 191, 133, 191, 177, and 163 on her way to a 1012 total. The MHSAA Finals will take place on Saturday at Century Bowl in Waterford.

SOUTHFIELD CHRISTIAN TOPS NOTRE DAME

The Notre Dame Boys Varsity Basketball team dropped a decision to perennial Class D State Championship contenders Southfield Christian 86-41. The Eagles took a 41-22 lead into halftime and remained in control throughout the remainder of the game. The Irish were led in scoring by Ethan Johnson with 12 points followed by Jack Risi with eight points.

JV BASKETBALL WIN STREAK REACHES 13 GAMES

The Notre Dame Boys JV Basketball team ended their season strong with wins over Flint Hamady and Goodrich. The Irish handily defeated Hamady 62-32 with Joe Yaldo (11 points), Billy Newman (10), Brian Lopez (nine), Drew Siegner (seven) and Luke Babich with (seven) leading the way offensively. The Irish won a competitive game against Goodrich 66-60, with Evan Noga (17), Yaldo (14), Lopez (11), Chris Galle (nine) and Newman (eight) all contributing offensively. The Irish finish the season with a 15-5 record and a 13-game winning streak.

NOTRE DAME FALLS TO GOODRICH

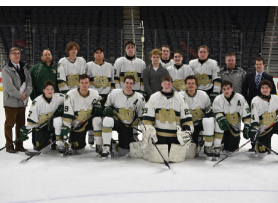
