It is your responsibility to be aware of the academic requirements including the minimum ACT score/SAT needed for the colleges you want to apply to as a Senior.

Minimal college requirements are listed below:

- English - 4 years
- Math – 3 years
- Science – 3 years
- Social Science – 3 years
- Fine or Applied Arts – 2 years
(generally art, music, or one world language)

Students who are involved in school sports and activities tend to have better grades, enjoy high school more, and increase their chances of acceptance to selective colleges.
