Circle one vaccine:		<p>For those vaccines where it is stated that a certain dose must be received on or after a certain birthday, a vaccine administered up to four days prior to the birthday is considered compliant. A valid laboratory report confirming serologic immunity to measles, mumps, rubella, hepatitis A, hepatitis B, or varicella is acceptable.</p> <p>KG-6th grade: 5 doses of diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccine are required, one of which must have been received on or after the fourth birthday. However, 4 doses will meet the requirement if at least 1 dose was received on or after the fourth birthday.</p> <p>For students 7 years of age and older, 3 doses of any tetanus/diphtheria-containing vaccine will meet the requirement if 1 dose was received on or after the 4th birthday.</p> <p>Students enrolled in K-12 prior to August 1, 2004 are considered in compliance if they received a booster dose of DTaP in the calendar month of (or prior to) their 4th birthday.</p> <p>7th grade: 1 dose of a tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis-containing vaccine is required if at least 5 years have passed since the last dose of tetanus-containing vaccine. If 5 years have not elapsed by entry into 7th grade, the dose will become due as soon as the 5-year interval has elapsed. Td vaccine is acceptable if Tdap is medically contraindicated.</p> <p>8th-12th grade: Students who have not already received Tdap are required to receive 1 dose when 10 years have elapsed since the last tetanus/diphtheria-containing vaccine.</p>

Circle one vaccine:		<p>K-12th Grade: 4 doses are required with the fourth dose received on or after the fourth birthday; or 3 doses if the third dose was received on or after the fourth birthday.</p> <p>Four doses of OPV and IPV in any combination by 4-6 years of age is considered a complete series regardless of the age at the third dose.</p> <p>Students 18 years of age or older: Polio vaccine is not required.</p> <p>Students enrolled in K-12 prior to August 1, 2004 shall be considered in compliance if a booster dose of IPV was received in the calendar month of (or prior to) the 4th birthday.</p>

Hepatitis B		<p>3 doses are required. In some circumstances, the US FDA may officially approve in writing the use of an alternative dosage schedule for this vaccine. Such an alternative regimen may be used only when they are fully documented with the vaccine manufacturer and dosage received for each dose of that vaccine.</p>

Hib		<p>Preschool Speech (PALS), Peer Models and PPCD A complete Hib series is 2 doses plus a booster dose on or after 12 months of age (3 doses total). If the first dose is received at 12-24 months of age, then only 1 additional dose is required (2 doses total). Any child who receives a single dose of Hib vaccine on or after 15 months of age is in compliance.</p>

Circle one vaccine:		<p>Preschool Speech (PALS), Peer Models and PPCD Children 7-11 months: 2 doses. Children 12-23 months: If 3 doses were received prior to 12 months, 4 doses are required with fourth dose on or after 12 months of age. If 1-2 doses were received prior to 12 months of age, 3 doses are required with at least one dose on or after 12 months of age. If zero doses have been received, then 2 doses are required with both doses on or after 12 months of age. Children 24-59 months need at least 3 doses with 1 dose on or after 12 months of age, or 2 doses with both doses on or after 12 months of age, or 1 dose on or after 24 months of age. Otherwise, 1 additional dose is required (4 total).</p>

Circle one vaccine:		<p>K-12th grade: 2 doses of MMR, with the first dose received on or after the first birthday. Students vaccinated prior to 2009 will satisfy this requirement if they received 2 doses of measles and 1 dose each of rubella and mumps on or after the first birthday.</p>

MMR • MMR/V		<p>K-12th grade: 2 doses are required with the first dose received on or after the first birthday or a written statement by a parent or physician stating the approximate month and year (MM/YY) that the student had chickenpox disease or varicella immunity.</p>

Chickenpox disease	(MM/YY)	<p>K-11th grade: 2 doses, with the first dose received on or after the first birthday 12th grade: the vaccine is optional</p>

Hepatitis A		<p>7th-12th grade: 1 dose of MCV4 is required on or after the student's eleventh birthday. One dose received on or after the tenth birthday also meets the requirement.</p>
